Day 1 (July 21): Anchorage - Whittier

Arrive in Anchorage this morning. We'll board our coach in the early afternoon for the hour transfer to Whittier. The ride offers outstanding views of Alaska's landscapes as we pass between the shorelines of Turnagain Arm and the peaks of the Chugach Mountains. Upon our arrival in Whittier, we will check in for our Alaskan Cruise aboard the Golden Princess. (D)

Day 2 (July 22) Cruising Hubbard Glacier

The largest tidewater glacier in North America, Hubbard Glacier measures 76 miles long

and plunges 1,200 feet into the depths of the bay. Its immense beauty and phenomenal blue hues are enchanting, even from afar. But it's when your cruise ship draws closer that its towering surface really impresses, dwarfing even the uppermost deck on your ship at a whopping 40 stories high. There, with the snowcapped mountains serving as a glorious backdrop, you'll have a prime viewing spot from which to witness the glacier calving, as it often expels icebergs the size of 10-story buildings-imagine the splash! (B, L, D)

Day 3 (July 23): Glacier Bay National Park

Princess is one of a select few cruise lines permitted to cruise the pristine waters of Glacier Bay. Take in the awe-inspiring scenery of this UNESCO World Heritage site as you enjoy an unforgettable day of sailing through this dazzling park. During your scenic cruise, friendly Park Rangers will join the ship to share their knowledge of this amazing

place. (B, L, D)

Day 4 (July 24): Skagway

During the Gold Rush era, Skagway - gateway to the Klondike - boasted 20,000 residents and a variety of saloons, dance halls and gambling palaces. A stroll along the town's streets will transport you back to days of the Klondike Gold Rush, as will a ride aboard the vintage White Pass & Yukon Route Railroad to the Klondike Summit and Yukon. (B, L, D)

Day 5 (July 25): Juneau

Take the Mt. Roberts Tramway for a bird's-eye view of the city in which prospector Jor Juneau hit the jackpot with three gold mines on the Gastineau Channel. Be sure to save time for a thriving city of cafés, galleries and seafood restaurants. Today you may choose to join an optional whale watching tour. (B, L, D)

Day 6 (July 26): Ketchikan

Charming Creek Street - one of Ketchikan's main attractions - was the town's red-light district during the Gold Rush days. Equally famous are Native totems on display at the Saxman Native Village and Totem Bight State Park, and the region's fabled salmon fishing. (B, L, D)

Day 7 (July 27): Day at Sea

Today enjoy a day onboard the ship relaxing, taking in the views, and participating in some of the onboard activities. (B, L, D)


