



Trails Regional Library will host "Divided Loyalties: Civil War Documents from the Missouri State Archives" December 9-27 at its Holden Branch, located at 207 S Main, Holden, MO.

In development for three years, the exhibit draws on more than 9 million pages of Civil War-related documents to examine the upheaval and uncertainty that characterized Missouri during the Civil War era. As Missourians divided their loyalties between the Union and the Confederacy, many found themselves facing dire consequences for their decisions.

The traveling exhibit, which was developed by the Missouri State Archives, focuses on the social conflict that permeated the state for the two decades that followed the Kansas border wars of the mid-1850s. Going beyond the stories of battle and military strategy, original documents demonstrate how even those Missourians who did not serve in the military could be subject to suspicion, discrimination, and violence.

Through state documents and court cases, Divided Loyalties covers all of Missouri's tumultuous Civil War history, from the Kansas-Missouri Border War to Reconstruction. The exhibit demonstrates that the war in Missouri was not fought solely on the battlefield. Rather, the conflict was so divisive it affected civilians and soldiers alike and lasted long after the war ended.

The role slavery played in dividing the state's population is explored, along with the lives of soldiers and civilians who faced discrimination and violence from both Union troops and bushwhackers. The exhibit also examines how the court system was used to settle grievances after the war, and when that failed, how some Missourians resorted to vigilante violence.

Some of the most noteworthy documents featured in the exhibit include court cases brought by slaves seeking their freedom, such as the famous suit filed by Dred and Harriet Scott; records from Missouri's pro-Confederate elected state government in exile and the federally-backed provisional government that took its place; muster rolls, company histories and military correspondence from the Missouri Adjutant General's office; a U.S. Colored Troops volunteer enlistment form; the 1865 Constitution that disenfranchised Southern sympathizers; and documents chronicling attempts to bring Frank and Jesse James to justice.

In conjunction with the exhibit, the library will hold a STEAM program for children ages 8-14 on Thursday, December 12. Participants will get to map a battlefield, find shelter for their troops, and trap enemies near rivers. Also, scavenger hunts for all ages will be available at the circulation desk while the exhibit is on display.

The exhibit is free and open to the public during regular library hours. Patrons will get a chance to view the exhibit once more at the Warrensburg and Odessa locations in early 2020. For more information regarding the exhibit, contact the library at (816) 732-4545.

Even though many businesses try delaying upgrades for as long as possible, this only prolongs the inevitable. The longer they wait, the more likely there will be support gaps — and that's not good. If you still haven't upgraded products reaching EOS in 2020, there's still time, but don't wait too long; many IT professionals have already scheduled EOS client upgrades for the remainder of the year.

There's also some good news if you don't wait until 2020 to upgrade, especially if you need to lower your taxable income for 2019: You can take advantage of the Section 179 deduction in the tax code.

What's Section 179 of the tax code, and how does it apply to my business?

Google's Cloud Print May Be Discontinued

Are you a fan of Google's Cloud Print service? It's fantastic because it allows you to print from anywhere to anywhere, which makes it utterly invaluable.

Like so many great services Google has introduced over the years, for a variety of reasons, the company has decided to pull the plug on it after keeping the service in Beta for more than a decade. The announcement came in the form of a terse note on the company's support page.

The note simply reads:

"Beginning January 1, 2021, devices across all operating systems will no longer be able to print using Google Cloud Print. We recommend that over the next year, you identify an alternative solution and execute a migration strategy."

If you use a Chromebook, this won't impact you at all, because Chrome OS or multi-OS environments that include Chrome OS have a feature called CUPS Printing. It is a viable replacement for Cloud Print.

Google added:

"For environments besides Chrome OS, or in multi-OS scenarios, we encourage you to use the respective platform's native printing infrastructure and/or partner with a print solutions provider."

Google has ended a surprising number of projects in 2019 as the company has tightened its focus, zeroing in on its core businesses. Google Cloud Print had a good run, though. First introduced back in 2011, the company originally touted it as a way for mobile and desktop users to print without having to worry about installing drivers. It proved to be exceptional in that regard and quickly grew to become one of the company's indispensable beta services.

Since its initial development, time and technology have moved on. Now, not only do most Operating Systems have native capabilities that replicate Cloud Print, but there are a few third-party providers out there that offer a more robust version of Google's offering. While it's sad to see the venerable product

go, it's also understandable. In any case, you've got plenty of time to find a replacement. If you're currently making use of it, start planning your migration now.


