Johnson County Remains in first step of Recovery through June 15

WARRENSBURG, Mo. (May 29, 2020) – Johnson County Community Health Services (JCCHS) announced that the county remains in the current step of recovery through Monday, June 15, 2020. This follows the recent extension for Phase 1 of the "Show Me Strong Recovery" Plan announced by Governor Mike Parson.

Johnson County's Recovery and Response Plan takes a step-by-step approach to help keep our communities safe during reopening. Movement through each step is determined by the spread or containment of COVID-19.

This first step has allowed all businesses to reopen with specific safety recommendations. Non-essential activities have been able to resume with limitations.

A re-entry task force is working to determine the best approach and recommendations for moving into the next step of recovery following the June 15 extension.

"We are very pleased with how well Johnson County residents have responded to COVID-19. While numbers continue to stay within a manageable level, it is important for everyone to remember to stay diligent," said Mary Thaut, JCCHS administrator. "We recognize this has not been easy; however, making these critical changes and sacrifices now will provide us with the ability to move forward to a more normal way of life later.

"We continue to encourage social distancing, staying home when you feel sick, and washing your hands regularly. Refer to state and CDC recommendations to protect yourself and those around you. Actions today will determine the reality of tomorrow," said Thaut.

Safety recommendations for individuals provided by the state include:

- Citizens who feel sick should stay home!
- Continue to practice good hygiene, including:
- Avoid socializing in groups that do not readily allow for appropriate physical distancing (receptions, trade shows, etc.). When in public (parks, outdoor recreation spaces, shopping malls, etc.), individuals should maximize physical distance from others.
- Minimize travel to the extent possible.

Safety recommendations for businesses provided by the state include:

- Prepare to implement basic infection prevention measures informed by industry best practices, regarding:
 - Protective equipment;

- Temperature checks;
- Testing, isolating, and contact tracing; and
- Sanitation, including disinfection of common and high-traffic areas (entrances, breakrooms, locations where there is high-frequency employee interaction with the public/customers).
- Modify physical workspaces to maximize social distancing.
- Minimize business travel.
- Develop an infectious disease preparedness and response plan, including policies and procedures for workforce contact tracing when an employee tests positive for COVID-19.
- Monitor workforce for indicative symptoms. Do not allow symptomatic people to physically return to work until cleared by a medical provider.
- Develop, implement, and communicate about workplace flexibilities and protections, including:
 - Encouraging telework whenever possible and feasible with business operations;
 - Returning to work in phases and/or split shifts, if possible;
 - Limiting access to common areas where personnel are likely to congregate and interact; and
 - Ensuring that sick leave policies are flexible and consistent with public health guidance.

CARES Funding Information



Johnson County is accepting applications for the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES) Funding. Local Government Agencies, Non-Profit entities and Small Businesses are eligible to apply for CARES Funds for expenses used for action taken to respond to the public health emergency. Please see the news release and the most recent guidance provided by the Missouri Treasurer's office as a reference for determining recipient qualification. Entities wishing to apply for CARES Funds will use the Application Form coming at a later date.

The following time line has been established for the first round of funding awards (\$2,000,000 cap in first round):
 June 1st - Applications are made available to entities
 June 19th - Applications for reimbursement of expenses incurred from March 1st to May 31st, 2020 with supporting documentation are due July 10th - Notification to applicant of the award decision will occur on or before this date

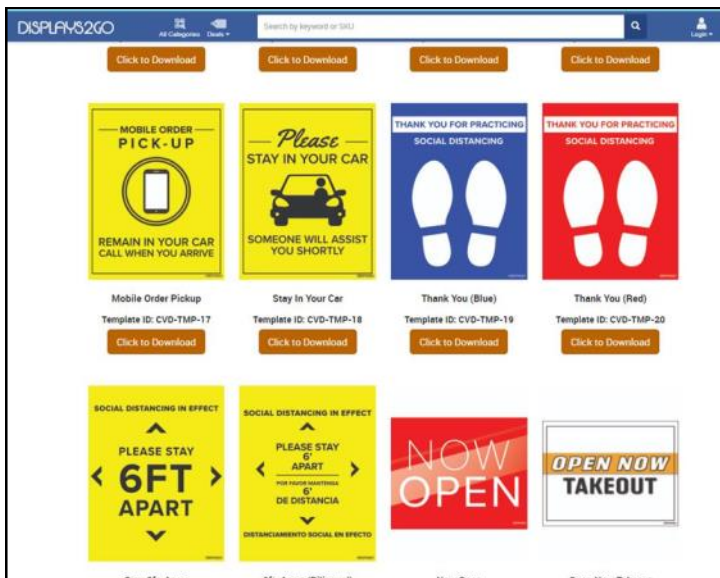
Additional rounds of funding will be made available after July 10th, with more information on those opportunities to follow.

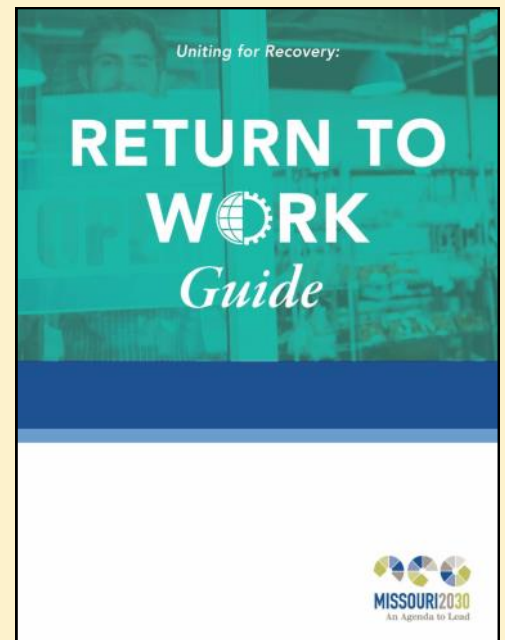



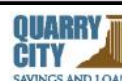

SEC 511. When issuing statements, press releases, requests for proposals, bid solicitations and other documents describing projects or programs funded in whole or in part with Federal money, all agencies receiving Federal funds, including but not limited to State and local governments, shall clearly state: 1) the percentage of the total costs of the program or project which will be financed with Federal money; 2) the dollar amount of Federal funds for the project or program; and 3) percentage and dollar amount of the total costs of the project or program that will be financed by non-governmental sources.

Add the hours your business is open (i.e. the regular customer-facing hours of operation for a typical week). For days when you have unusual hours, like holidays or special events, **set special hours**. Learn more about hours guidelines:

To set hours, follow these steps:

- Sign in to Google My Business. If you have multiple locations, open the location you'd like to manage.
- Click Info from the menu.
- Next to "Add hours" or your current business hours, click Hours.
- Turn on each day of the week that your business is open.
- Next to each day of the week that your business is open, click Opens at, and then select the opening time.
- Next to each day of the week that your business is open, click Closes at, and then select the closing time.
- After you're done setting your hours, click Apply.

Set business hour breaks

To indicate your business hours include a break, create 2 entries for the same day with different times.

For example, if your business is open from 9 AM–2 PM on Saturdays, closed from 2 PM–5 PM, then open again from 5 PM–10 PM:

1. Turn on Saturday.
2. Next to "Saturday," click Opens at 9:00 AM.
3. Next to "Saturday," click Closes at 2:00 PM.
4. Next to "Saturday," click Opens at 5:00 PM.
5. Next to "Saturday," click Closes at 10:00 PM.

Set 24-hour business hours

Next to each day of the week that your business is open, click Opens at 24 hours.

Set special hours

On your computer, sign in to Google My Business.

- If you have multiple locations, open the location you'd like to manage.
- Click Info > **Special hours**. (You'll only find this section if you've already provided regular hours.)
- Next to an upcoming holiday, click **Confirm hours**. Or to choose a different date, click **Add new date**.
- Enter the opening and closing times for that day.
- To mark the location as closed all day, slide the circle to "Closed."
- If you're open 24 hours, click **Opens at**, and from the drop down menu select **24 hours**.
- If you enter closing hours past midnight, make sure to set them properly.
- When you've finished entering all of your special hours, click **Apply**. Your special hours will appear to customers on Google only for the designated days.



- Log in to your Facebook account and go to your Business Page.
- Click About on the left side of your Business Page.
- Click Edit Page Info.
- Click the Hours tab at the top.
- Add or edit your hours and click Save Changes.

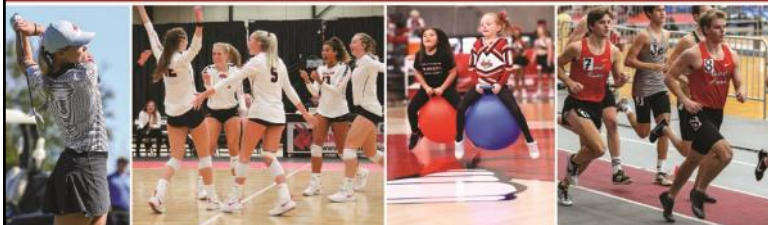

Children are not going to school, activities, places of worship and other public places where adults look out for their safety and well-being.

Trust your Gut

If something does not look safe, sound safe or feel safe - report.

Making a Report is Asking for Help and Services

When you report, you are asking for a professional to help a child and their family. You do not need proof. You are not making an accusation.

You May Be the Only Person to Act

If you reasonably suspect a child is unsafe - report.

Anonymous reports are accepted from anyone. Anyone making a report in good faith is protected against civil/criminal penalty or adverse employment action. Your identity is held confidential and will not be revealed.

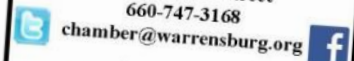
