Mission Statement

"Shop with a Cop" benefits needy or neglected children from the Johnson County Area at our annual event held in mid-December. This program has been a large success in many communities across the nation including our own. Each year, "Shop with a Cop" provides a joyful holiday for underprivileged children who, without this event, may not experience one. The participating children are identified by local agencies, schools and churches.

On the day of the event (Mid December), uniformed officers from the Warrensburg Police Department, University of Central Missouri Public Safety, Johnson County Sheriff's Department, Knob Noster Police Department, and officers from different State Agencies volunteer their time to be with the children. This year's event will look a bit different from those in the past due to Covid-19. The event begins and ends at Walmart this year where the children participate in an evening of shopping with their law enforcement partner. Each child is assigned to a single officer and a helper and are provided with \$125 in spending money to spend on themselves and their family. A portion of that money is dedicated to the needs of the child (clothing, coat, shoes, toiletries, etc)

This event is fully funded by donations and yearly fund raisers. We strive to raise enough money to accommodate at least 25 children. The program was designed to benefit underprivileged children between the ages of five and eleven years old. Our goal is to provide a happier holiday season to these children and to have the children interact with law enforcement officers in a positive setting.

Mission Statement: Photo Gym is the culmination of a lifetime spent working with photos and files; helping individuals and organizations tackle the challenge of accessing their photos for historical, documentation, efficiency and marketing purposes.

What made you want to get a membership with the chamber?

The Chamber is a great way to support the community while connecting with other local businesses. This Chamber, more than most, provides a ton of opportunities for marketing, advertising, and offers support for just about any issue a small business might encounter. I especially like that the Warrensburg Chamber is active in the community.

What do you love most about Warrensburg?

It has a small town feel but we have a large influence from students attending the University of Central Missouri, airmen and families from Whiteman Air Force Base, and visitors from surrounding towns. I love that "melting pot" feel of different cultures!

Why are you passionate about your business?

We are passionate about our business because we believe it's important for people to preserve their photos and videos. It's not just the individual's story that is being protected but also the story of our era and our heritage as people.

What makes your business unique?

Photo organization and the other services we provide are unique but the thing we pride ourselves on most is that we listen to our customers' needs and desires for preserving their memories and strive to accommodate anything they come up with. We provide quality products and our staff are excited about their work and knowledgeable about getting people the help they need.

How long have you owned your business?

We began Photo Gym in 2017 from our basement. After a year there, we ran out of space for both client work and equipment so we ventured out into the public. We wanted to find out if the membership model we had in mind was viable before opening a brick and mortar storefront. So, we held "Open Gym" at the Jack Moore Community Room every other Thursday and were thrilled that people came every single time! Two years later, amidst the COVID-19 pandemic, we needed more space so we moved again to our current location at 604 N. Maguire Street, also in Warrensburg.

How and why did you get started in this line of work?

Our founders, Dan and Kathy Baldridge, have over 50 years of combined experience in both technology and photo finishing. In today's world of digital photos, that's a really powerful combination! In 2009 or so, they were both at the Consumer Electronics Show in Las Vegas and Kathy heard the founder of the Association of Professional Photo Organizers speak and she quickly knew this was the direction she wanted to take. At Photo Gym they are able to apply the knowledge they have gained over the years, working for large corporations, to

personal collections, ensuring those memories are preserved and protected for future generations.

What is your favorite aspect of your job?

The tears. So often, when people are able to see and hear a loved one who has passed or their babies who now have babies of their own, they cry. When people are crying with happiness, it reaffirms we are doing important work.

In what ways has your business grown and developed over the years?

We have grown in a multitude of ways, growth is essential to our existence! One of the most important aspects of what we do is to listen and address people's concerns. Though most people have similar themes in their collections, what they want to do with them varies widely. We have added archival quality solutions for slide and negative scanning, we expanded our retail area to include organization, storage, and display options to help our customers find solutions not available elsewhere and, with our newest location, we also offer printing to provide a higher quality product than is available at the local big box stores.

In what ways has your business helped the local community?

We partner with RISE Community Services to provide volunteer opportunities as often as possible. It's not unusual to have a RISE volunteer working at Photo Gym 3-4 days a week! We began sponsoring programming on the local PBS station last year. This past season, we were thrilled to sponsor "Finding Your Roots" as we feel family roots are the heart of what we do at Photo Gym! We participate in local events, donate to the public school and local charities, support the Muleskinner, whatever we can do we will do to help in the community. Personally, Dan and Kathy are both active in the community and serve on Boards and Committees as often as possible.

In your opinion, what is the most enjoyable part of being able to serve the Warrensburg Community?

Warrensburg is what I consider "right sized", meaning not so large you lose track of what's happening in the community but not so small there is no opportunity. Since opening Photo Gym, we have met so many families and learned the stories of their lives. We often feel like we are part of their lives when we are helping put the story together for them to share and that never stops being enjoyable!


Online Building Permits

Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)

The LJHEAP Program can help you pay your main heating and cooling bills. The Program helps low-income people meet their immediate energy needs.

To qualify for assistance, you must meet each of the following requirements:

- · Be the person responsible for paying home heating and cooling costs
- Be a United States citizen or have been legally admitted for permanent residence.
- · Have \$3000 or less in bank accounts, retirement accounts or investments
- · Meet specific meome guidelines that vary according to household size

Energy Assistance (EA)

EA will give you a one-time payment to your primary heating source. The amount of help you received is based on the number in your household, your household income and the type of heating source used in your home. Applications are accepted during the months of November March.

Energy Crisis Intervention Program (ECIP)

ECIP can help pay your fuel bills when your utility is shut off or threatened to be shut off. The amount of help you receive is based on the amount of money needed to settle your crisis with the energy provider.

Winter ECTP – is available November – May based on funding. The maximum amount you could receive is \$800 – Winter ECIP can be used for the primary and secondary heating source

Summer ECIP—is available June-September based on funding. The maximum amount you could receive is \$600. Summer ECIP can only be used for electric.





TIP: That annoying mirror, turn it off!

Dr. Tara Well, a psychologist at Barnard College says, like a mirror, a video call "shows your quirks, emotions, and reactions in real time and this is of course stressful, distracting, and unsettling. In fact, a survey found that 72% of employees reported feeling distracted by their own appearance during video calls, and 59% felt more self-conscious on screen than in-person."

Here are some good tips from TalentSmart on *How to* Increase Your Confidence, Connections, & Energy in Virtual Meetings:

- 1. Set up your computer so the camera is eye level and about three feet away. Rather than just a 'giant talking head', your upper body is in view and others can see your natural movements.
- 2. When you're speaking, focus on the camera lens.
- 3. When not speaking, actively observe the person who is speaking.



TIP: Surprising research: video call or phone call?

Which is best? You would think that seeing AND talking to someone would make you feel more connected, but Nicholas Epley, professor of Behavioral Science at the University of Chicago Booth School of Business, and Amit Kumar, assistant professor of marketing and psychology at the University of Texas, say that's not what the research shows. "Being able to see another person, in short, did not make people feel any more connected than if they simply talked with them. A sense of connection does not seem to come from being able see another person but rather from hearing another person's voice."

We were surprised by this! So our tip for you this week is this: Why not encourage people on your team to use the phone more often to connect with colleagues, customers and clients?





UPDATE YOUR BUSINESS HOURS



Add the hours your business is open (i.e. the regular customer-facing hours of operation for a typical week). For days when you have unusual hours, like holidays or special events, set special hours. Learn more about hours guidelines:

To set hours, follow these steps:

- Sign in to Google My Business. If you have multiple locations, open the location you'd like to manage.
- Click Info from the menu.
- Next to "Add hours" or your current business hours, click Hours.
- Turn on each day of the week that your business is open.
- Next to each day of the week that your business is open, click Opens at, and then select the opening time.
- Next to each day of the week that your business is open, click Closes at, and then select the closing time.
- After you're done setting your hours, click Apply.

Set business hour breaks

To indicate your business hours include a break, create 2 entries for the same day with different times.

For example, if your business is open from 9 AM-2 PM on Saturdays, closed from 2 PM-5 PM, then open again from 5 PM-10 PM:

- Turn on Saturday.
- 2. Next to "Saturday," click Opens at 9:00 AM.
- 3. Next to "Saturday, click Closes at 2:00 PM.
- 4. Next to "Saturday," click Opens at 5:00 PM.
- Next to "Saturday, click Closes at 10:00 PM.

Set 24-hour business hours

Next to each day of the week that your business is open, click Opens at 24 hours.

Set special hours

On your computer, sign in to Google My Business.

- If you have multiple locations, open the location you'd like to manage.
- Click Info > Special hours. (You'll only find this section if you've already provided regular hours.)
- Next to an upcoming holiday, click Confirm hours. Or to choose a different date, click Add new date.
- Enter the opening and closing times for that day.
- To mark the location as closed all day, slide the circle to "Closed."
- If you're open 24 hours, click Opens at, and from the drop down menu select 24 hours.
- If you enter closing hours past midnight, make sure to set them properly.
- When you've finished entering all of your special hours, click Apply. Your special hours will appear to customers on Google only for the designated days.



- Log in to your Facebook account and go to your Business Page.
- Click About on the left side of your Business Page.
- Click Edit Page Info.
- · Click the Hours tab at the top.


