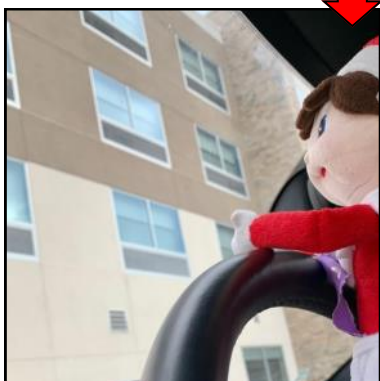

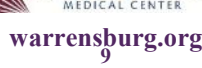
In what ways has your business helped the local community?

Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)

The LIHEAP Program can help you pay your main heating and cooling bills. The Program helps low-income people meet their immediate energy needs.

To qualify for assistance, you must meet each of the following requirements:

- Be the person responsible for paying home heating and cooling costs
- Be a United States citizen or have been legally admitted for permanent residence
- Have \$3000 or less in bank accounts, retirement accounts or investments
- Meet specific income guidelines that vary according to household size

Energy Assistance (EA)

EA will give you a one-time payment to your primary heating source. The amount of help you received is based on the number in your household, your household income and the type of heating source used in your home. Applications are accepted during the months of November-March.

Energy Crisis Intervention Program (ECIP)

ECIP can help pay your fuel bills when your utility is shut off or threatened to be shut off. The amount of help you receive is based on the amount of money needed to settle your crisis with the energy provider.

Winter ECIP - is available November - May based on funding. The maximum amount you could receive is \$800. Winter ECIP can be used for the primary and secondary heating source.

Summer ECIP - is available June- September based on funding. The maximum amount you could receive is \$600. Summer ECIP can only be used for electric.

COVID-19 Vaccine in Johnson County

WARRENSBURG, Mo. (Dec. 15, 2020) – Johnson County Community Health Services (JCCHS) is currently working through plans on distribution and administering the COVID-19 vaccine. Phase 1-A for healthcare workers and long-term care facilities will begin soon.

The Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS) allocated the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine to counties across the state. The vaccine was authorized for emergency use by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration on Friday night, Dec. 11, 2020. The vaccine is a series of two doses administered three weeks apart.

The schedule for vaccine distribution according to the state is:

Phase 1-A: Healthcare Workers and long-term care facilities.

Phase 1-B: Emergency response and essential workers.

Phase 2: Additional Phase-1 populations if not vaccinated in Phase 1, high risk populations and potentially all Missouri residents (as availability increases).

Phase 3: All Missouri residents – expected in spring or early summer and is dependent on vaccine availability.

JCCHS is working closely with local partners for storage and county-wide distribution plans of the COVID-19 vaccine.

Below are common questions that are answered by the latest guidance issued by DHSS:

What do I do if I miss the second dose 21 days after the first dose? Patients who do not receive the second vaccination dose at 21 days should still receive that second dose as soon as possible thereafter.

Should you get the vaccine if you have already contracted COVID-19? Yes, but for both symptomatic and asymptomatic COVID-19 patients, you should defer vaccination until you have met criteria to discontinue isolation.

Can you receive the vaccine if you are pregnant?

Yes, pregnant females are recommended for the vaccine depending on the individual's risk of acquisition due to the level of community transmission, personal risk of contracting COVID-19 due to occupation or other activities, risks of COVID-19 to the mother and potential risks to the fetus, efficacy of the vaccine, known side effects of the vaccine and the lack of data about the vaccine during pregnancy. Special counseling and a 15-minute observation period after vaccination, if chosen, is recommended.

Women who are pregnant or breastfeeding are encouraged to discuss vaccination with their primary care physician or OB prior to receiving the vaccine. A physician's order could be required.

Should you have a pregnancy test or antibody test prior to receiving the vaccine?

Routine testing for pregnancy or antibody tests is not recommended in relation to vaccine use.

Can you get this vaccine if you are in quarantine due to an exposure with a positive COVID-19 case?

You should delay your vaccination if you have had a known SARS-CoV-2 (virus that causes COVID-19) exposure until your quarantine period has ended, unless residing in a congregate setting (health care/long-term care facility, correctional facility, homeless shelter, etc.).

Can you get the flu shot and COVID-19 vaccine at the same time?

There is no information on co-administration of this COVID-19 vaccine with other vaccines. The Pfizer vaccine should be spaced at least 14 days from any other vaccine.

If you have been vaccinated, can you stop from using other precautions?

While experts learn more about the protection that COVID-19 vaccines provide under real-life conditions, it will be important for everyone to continue using all the tools available to us to help stop this pandemic, like covering your mouth and nose with a mask, washing hands often, and staying at least 6 feet away from others. Together, COVID-19 vaccination and following CDC's recommendations for how to protect yourself and others will offer the best protection from getting and spreading COVID-19.

Who is not recommended for the Pfizer vaccine?

Those under age 16.

An individual who has experienced a serious reaction (e.g., anaphylaxis) to a prior dose of a COVID-19 vaccine or to any of its components. For information on vaccine components, refer to the manufacturers' package insert.

This vaccine is free or low-cost. Doses provided by the federal government are provided to Missourians at no cost. However, vaccinators can charge an administration fee for giving someone the shot. A maximum fee amount has not been set at this time. Most insurance companies will cover an administration fee.

Most importantly, Missouri residents cannot be denied a vaccine if they cannot afford the administration fee or do not have insurance.

Most reported side effects were mild and include pain at the injection site, tiredness, headache, muscle pain, chills, joint pain, and fever. Of note, more people experienced these side effects after the second dose than after the first dose.

JCCHS continues to recommend following safety precautions as the county moves toward vaccine distribution completion. These include the 3Ws. Wear a mask, watch your distance and wash your hands.

Back on May 11, 2020, about two months into the COVID-19 pandemic that closed most live event spaces around the world, the Event Safety Alliance released *The Event Safety Alliance Reopening Guide*. With contributions from more than 300 smart friends from every aspect of entertainment and sports production, ESA created detailed guidance regarding the health and safety issues likely to arise as event professionals contemplate reopening. We are gratified to report that the *Reopening Guide* has been downloaded over 30,000 times, translated into several languages, and cited by industry professionals and organizations around the globe.

Now that exactly six months of this interminable year have passed, we’ve released an update that highlights what we have learned about how event professionals might safely get through this pandemic, provides links to useful materials, and updates our recommendations based on the current science and experiences of those attempting to resume live events. We hope this update will serve as a useful companion to the original guidance.

Johnson County Quarantine Guidelines for COVID-19

The CDC recently revised the current COVID-19 quarantine guidelines to allow communities options to shorten the quarantine period. However, the newly-modified guidance still strongly recommends following the existing 14-day quarantine when identified as a close contact.

The Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS) encourages local communities consider a tiered-approach that includes reduced quarantine restrictions **when the local community is within a County Action Plan Level 3 status or better.**

Currently, Johnson County is at or near a 15% positivity rate and is currently in the **Level 1: Extreme Risk Category** as defined in the state’s Public Health Warning released by DHSS. Due to this level, the state recommends that the quarantine protocol remain 14 days.

At this time, JCCHS will continue with the existing 14-day quarantine. Please note, according to DHSS, communities can move down in the risk category after two consecutive weeks of meeting the next lower level criteria.

JCCHS will continue to monitor community transmission, and revisit quarantine time frames when positivity rate reaches 10% or less. The goal is the health and safety of our communities.

S&P Global Ratings Assign UCM 'A+' Long-term Rating for Fourth Year

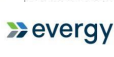

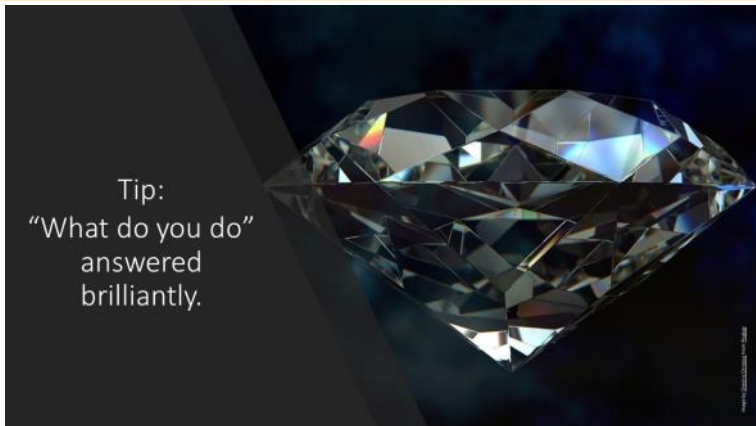

TIP: "What do you do?" answered brilliantly.

We encourage people to paint a picture by using an example when asked, "So, what do you do?" This is especially important if you work in more complicated fields such as technology, health research or science. You want the listener to understand and relate to your answer.

With the news of a COVID-19 vaccine rollout we read this brilliant explanation from Acuitas Therapeutics about the delivery system they developed for the new Pfizer/BioNTech vaccine.

Here's what Acuitas does, technically speaking:

"The delivery system made by Acuitas are lipid nanoparticles about 80 nanometres in size that protect the vaccine made out of messenger RNA (mRNA) once it's injected. Lipids are organic compounds and key parts of the structure and function of cells. Nanotechnology devices were originally made out of metals and ceramics, but now nano devices are being made out of biomolecules such as lipids. Messenger RNA tells the body to make proteins based on the genetic blueprint provided by DNA."

Got that? If not, here's how they complete their answer!

Acuitas compares its lipid nanoparticles to a delivery technology used to ship a fragile glass ornament to your home. Except that the package being delivered is the vaccine.

"No matter how bumpy or rough the journey was, our delivery technology would make sure that the ornament was protected," Acuitas says in a backgrounder. "Our carrier would find your house, open the front door by itself, let itself in, unwrap your glass ornament and leave it in the front hallway for you to pick up."

If "So, what do you do?" is a challenge for you, this tip might inspire you to come up with a better answer to a question you get asked all the time.

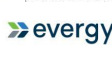
