Trails Regional Library is altering its material quarantine procedures to better reflect data surrounding COVID-19 transmission. Effective immediately, all returned materials will be quarantined for 2 days instead of 4.

Patrons can continue to place holds online or over the phone and arrange Curbside pick up at any of our branch locations. Printing services are also available via curbside with up to 10 pages printed free of charge per patron.
