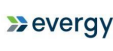

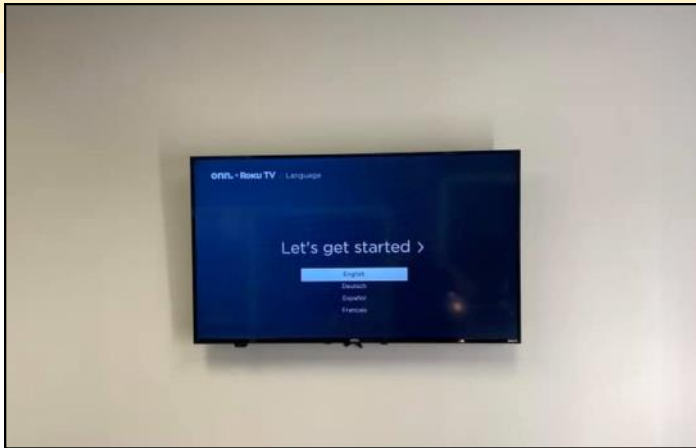

The Warrensburg Chamber of Commerce hosted a ribbon cutting ceremony Wednesday, March 10, at the Old Drum Animal Shelter, welcoming Warrensburg Animal Rescue as a chamber member.

WAR took on the operation of the shelter Jan. 1, 2021. The shelter was previously operated as part of the City of Warrensburg.

"I think joining different associations will help us to connect with other organizations so that we can, maybe, mutually benefit from each other," WAR President Mason Wirsig said.

Chamber member Suzy Latore said the shelter helps the county to live up to the name of Home of Man's Best Friend.

Shelter Director Kayla Frank said the chamber membership helps the shelter build connections with other businesses and organizations.

The T-Mobile Truck was a sponsor of the event and provided refreshments.

Frank said since January, the shelter has increased the number of staff, raised standards of animal care have gotten better. The shelter has three full-time staff members and three part-time staff members.

Wirsig said the WAR board is waiting to move ahead with some goals because of the Prop A ballot measure.

"Our focus is always on the animals, we can focus more on that (if it passes)," Wirsig said. "If it doesn't pass ... the board will have to focus on other ways to raise money, to fundraise. It's a huge budget."

The ballot measure, if passed, would allocate funds collected from sales tax for the shelter.

"We are continuing fundraising opportunities just because the budget for next year is still unknown," Frank said. [READ MORE](#)

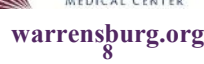
In what ways has your business helped the local community?

COVID-19 Vaccine in Johnson County

WARRENSBURG, Mo. (Dec. 15, 2020) – Johnson County Community Health Services (JCCHS) is currently working through plans on distribution and administering the COVID-19 vaccine. Phase 1-A for healthcare workers and long-term care facilities will begin soon.

The Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS) allocated the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine to counties across the state. The vaccine was authorized for emergency use by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration on Friday night, Dec. 11, 2020. The vaccine is a series of two doses administered three weeks apart.

Quarantine for Vaccinated Persons

Get 1st Dose

Get the first dose of your vaccine, Pfizer or Moderna. If you receive Johnson & Johnson, you can skip to Step 4.

STEP 01



Waiting Period

The time between your first and second dose of the Pfizer (21 days) or Moderna (28 days) vaccine.

STEP 02



Get 2nd Dose

Get the second dose of your Pfizer or Moderna vaccine - the same brand as your first.

STEP 03



Waiting Period

This is a two week period before the vaccine is considered fully effective.

STEP 04

Post-Vaccination

After the two week waiting period, you are not required to quarantine if exposed to a suspected or confirmed COVID-19 case, and do not develop symptoms during the 14 days after exposure.

STEP 05



Continue to wear a mask and practice good hand hygiene, and maintain social distance from those outside of your immediate household.

Guidance does not apply to inpatients or residents in a healthcare setting.

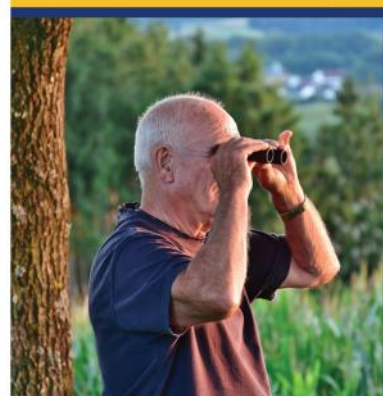

How to build a network.

Vernon Jordan

August 15, 1935 – March 1, 2021



TIP: From grandson of a sharecropper to one of the most connected people in America.

Vernon Jordan died on March 1st at the age of 85. According to Yale Professor Marissa King, "His unparalleled ability to network allowed the grandson of a sharecropper to become 'one of the most connected men in America.' Jordan was the civil rights movement's ambassador to boardrooms."

In her book, *Social Chemistry*, King explains how he did that. She describes it as "thousands of invisible threads he spun together". She says Jordan's "ascent can be traced to the key role he has played brokering between the worlds of business and politics, as well as across racial lines. Vernon described his brokering role, stating: 'When you're on the outside and as connected as I am, there's an opportunity to interpret.'" Jordan used "being on the outside" as opportunity.

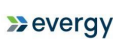

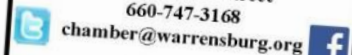
