





Journey Home of Johnson Co.

The Warrensburg Chamber of Commerce hosted a ribbon cutting ceremony Monday, Feb. 22, to welcome Journey Home, one of the county's two permanent homeless shelters, as a new Chamber member.

Journey Home Board member Mary McCord said being a member of the Chamber provides opportunities for networking, publicity and obtaining community support, which all help Journey Home provide its services to the community.

Journey Home officially opened Nov. 2, 2020, and is located at 16 S.W. 265 Road, Warrensburg.

In addition to providing an emergency shelter, Journey Home works to connect individuals with health management and mental health management, help build job-seeking skills and help obtain individuals' missing documents.

"We try to wrap other services that other people do around that person to help them meet whatever goal they have," McCord said.

Journey Home Board member Erica Jones-Collins said since the shelter's opening, the organization has been able to house and transition 11 individuals into transitional or permanent housing.

Jones-Collins said those moving into transitional housing can still receive services from Journey Home such as receiving assistance with budgeting, obtaining transportation, obtaining insurance and obtaining furniture.

Those wanting to support Journey Home can do so by volunteering and donating food, clothing and funds. Journey Home also has an Adopt-A-Bed program where individuals or a group of people can donate the cost of housing for an individual each month, which is about \$200. <u>READ MORE</u>



Honor Detailing

The Warrensburg Chamber of Commerce hosted a ribbon cutting ceremony Tuesday, Feb. 23, to welcome its new Chamber member, Honor Detailing.

Honor Detailing opened its doors May 4, 2020, and provides exterior and interior vehicle detailing as well as power-washing for buildings.

Customers can come by their location for services, but the business also provides mobile services to the local community as well as residents in locations such as Independence and Blue Springs.

Honor Detailing co-owner Joshua Murphy said he had planned to open the business at the end of March 2020 and had already planned the grand opening, but the COVID-19 pandemic and stay -at-home orders pushed the business' opening to May of that year.

Honor Detailing was initially located in a converted manual wash bay in Knob Noster, but the business switched locations to its current address at 7 SE State Highway J, Knob Noster, in November 2020.

Murphy said the new location allows the business to remain open during the winter months, which wasn't possible at the previous one.

Murphy said while the old location only had one bay that was open to the elements, the new location has two bays as well as doors to keep winter weather out as employees work on vehicles.

"We've worked in 108-degree temperatures and we've worked in 21-degree weather," Murphy said. "When you're working in elements like that, it's actually very difficult to do certain types of details in those temperatures if you're outside because blacks won't adhere to a vehicle when it's too cold, so you have to have it in a more controlled environment." <u>READ MORE</u>



Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)

The LIHEAP Program can help you pay your main heating and cooling bills. The Program helps low-income people meet their immediate energy needs.

To qualify for assistance, you must meet each of the following requirements:

- Be the person responsible for paying home heating and cooling costs.
- Be a United States entitien or have been legally admitted for permanent residence
- Have \$3000 or less in bank accounts, retirement accounts or investments
- Meet specific income guidelines that vary according to household size

Energy Assistance (EA)

EA will give you a one-time payment to your primary heating source. The amount of help you received is based on the number in your household, your household income and the type of heating source used in your home. Applications are accepted during the months of November March

Energy Crisis Intervention Program (ECIP)

ECIP can help pay your fuel bills when your utility is shut off or threatened to be shut off. The amount of help you receive is based on the amount of money needed to settle your crisis with the energy provider.

Winter ECIP - is available November - May based on funding. The maximum amount you could receive is \$800. Winter ECIP can be used for the primary and secondary heating source

Summer ECIP - is available June- September based on funding. The maximum amount you could receive is \$600. Summer ECIP can only be used for electric.

Calling all teachers and youth!!!!!! Are you looking for a lesson plan, do you have a student who is interested in oratory and /or essay writing? Each year, the Optimist International Foundation promotes both an essay and oratorical contest, with the Optimist Club of Warensburg hosting our local oratorical on March 25 and we need participants. This would be a great educational block to help students prepare and present their views through the oratorical contest or voice their thoughts through creative writing with the essay contest. This is also a great opportunity to earn scholarship \$\$\$\$ as well as gain speaking experience.

Since its start in 1928, the Optimist Oratorical Contest has become the longest-running program sponsored by Optimist International. This year's oratorical topic' Healing The World With Optimism'' is the theme with a very broad spectrum of interpretation. The contest is designed for youth to gain experience in the start of th public speaking and provide them with the opportunity to compete for a college scholarship. It is very easy to apply for the contest. Interested students should prepare a 4- to 5-minute speech on the assigned topic to present at the contest. The speeches are judged at the Club level, Regional level (if needed) and then at the District level. Our first and second place winners will go directly to Regionals' to compete for a \$500 award. District winners get scholarships of \$2500, \$1500 and \$1000.

Optimist International will also host an essay contest as well This years topic, "Reaching Your Dreams by Choosing Optimism includes the ready context is that this year topic, the stand of the standard with the chance to share their thoughts during this most interesting of times. The essay winner can win up to \$2500 at the district level, with the deadline for submissions for this context being Feb 19.

Youth of all ages are encouraged to compete and gain experience and give their view on the topic. The contest is open to youth under the age of 19 as of October 1st of the current Optimist International contest year (October 1 – September 30) and is not enrolled as a degree seeking student of a post-secondary institution. There is no minimum age.

JCCHS Reduces COVID-19 **Quarantine Restrictions**

WARRENSBURG, Mo. (March 2, 2021) - Johnson County Community Health Services (JCCHS) has reduced guarantine restrictions for anyone who may have been exposed to COVID-19. The time required for a close contact to quarantine is reduced from 14 to 10 days.

Based on our current decrease in positive COVID-19 cases, JCCHS recommends decreasing the existing 14 day guarantine period to 10 days based on the following:

Quarantine can end after day 10 without testing if no symptoms have been reported, and the individual continues to wear a mask.

End to quarantine after the completion of 10 full days for ASYMPTO-MATIC individuals, provided that monitoring continues throughout the full 14 days. If symptoms develop, the individual should contact a public health authority or healthcare provider immediately.

Johnson County has a seven percent positivity rate, and is identified as a Level 3 County: Serious Risk Category. This is defined in the state's Public Health Warning released by the Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS).

DHSS strongly encourages local communities to consider a tieredapproach that includes reduced guarantine restrictions when the local community is within a County Action Plan Level 3 status or better.

County Action Plan Levels are defined in the state's Public Health Warning, and may be reviewed here: https://health.mo.gov/living/ healthcondiseases/communicable/novel-coronavirus/pdf/advisory-20201119.pdf.

Please note, according to DHSS, communities can move down in the risk category after two consecutive weeks of meeting the next lower level criteria. Johnson County has moved down in the risk category, therefore, lessening quarantine restrictions.

As a reminder, guidance regarding isolation for confirmed COVID-19 cases remains unchanged. This newly-modified CDC guidance is not authorized for reduced timeframes for guarantine in nursing facilities or long-term care facilities.

COVID-19 Vaccine in Johnson County

WARRENSBURG, Mo. (Dec. 15, 2020) - Johnson County Community Health Services (JCCHS) is currently working through plans on distribution and administering the COVID-19 vaccine. Phase 1-A for healthcare workers and long-term care facilities will begin soon.

The Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS) allocated the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine to counties across the state. The vaccine was authorized for emergency use by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration on Friday night, Dec. 11, 2020. The vaccine is a series of two doses administered three weeks apart.

The schedule for vaccine distribution according to the state is: Phase 1-A: Healthcare Workers and long-term care facilities. Phase 1-B: Emergency response and essential workers. Phase 2: Additional Phase-1 populations if not vaccinated in Phase 1, high risk populations and potentially all Missouri residents (as availability increases).

Phase 3: All Missouri residents - expected in spring or early summer and is dependent on vaccine availability.





Breakout rooms in "zoom calls" are often the networking piece of the event because it's where more manageable conversations can be had. However, we recently experienced a breakout room where the person tasked with being the facilitator didn't take charge. They expected that when one person finished talking, someone else would speak up. Breakout rooms need more direction than this. Ellen Keiley in an article, Are the rules different for virtual networking? offers some good advice if you end up in the facilitator role.

As an icebreaker, "Suggest that everyone go around and introduce themselves: who they are, what they do, and maybe something brief about themselves, such as where they live, where their office is located, or a fun fact. The goal is to connect the dots with others and find common ground for conversation."

Remember, many people are reluctant to jump in and talk in these virtual settings, so take charge of the discussions. Use a technique that broadcast journalists use when they "toss" a portion of the show to another anchor or reporter. When you finish speaking, toss the conversation to someone else. 


