Trails Regional Library Launches Self Checkout Machines

Trails Regional Library launched self checkout machines at 6 branches last week. These machines were funded in part through 2020 CARES Act funding from the Johnson County, Missouri government. The self checkouts will allow patrons a safe, contactless, and private way to check out library materials, check their accounts, and pay for lost or damaged item fees.

The self checkout machines utilize RFID tag technology, which lets users place all items on the pad without scanning individual barcodes. The benefit to providing the machines now includes increased privacy for patron selections, faster lines during the busy summer months, and reduced contact for those who are in populations more vulnerable to COVID-19.

The Warrensburg, Odessa, Lexington, Holden, Concordia, and Knob Noster branches currently have at least one self checkout machine operating. Smaller branches, including Corder, Waverly, and the Leeton Express Branch, do not have self checkout machines due to limited space.

Amtrak Missouri River Runner Returns to Two Daily Round-Trip Trains

JEFFERSON CITY - The State of Missouri and Amtrak will restore the second of two daily roundtrip trains on the Amtrak MidwestSM Missouri River Runner line between the Amtrak stations in Kansas City and St. Louis starting July 19. Funding from the State of Missouri and the federal American Rescue Plan Act will keep those two round-trip trains running through the end of December 2021. This service was reduced to one round-trip each day in March 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

"We appreciate the General Assembly and Gov. Parson providing necessary resources for the Amtrak Missouri River Runner service in the state's budget as well as the additional COVID relief funds enabling us to restore this important transportation service to Missourians," said Missouri Department of Transportation Director Patrick McKenna. "The two daily round-trip trains will be available through December covering the busiest time of the year including summer vacations, fall festivals and year-end holiday travel. We will re-evaluate the situation this fall based on the actions at the federal level with the renewal of the federal transportation budget to determine how long we can support the two daily round-trip service.'

"We also extend our thanks to Gov. Parson and the Legislature for their actions and for the steadfast, statewide support from the Missouri Rail Passenger Advisory Committee," said Ray Lang, Amtrak Vice President for state-sponsored services. "Our valued relationship with MoDOT goes back to 1979 and we look forward to improving the already reliable service by the debut of new U.S.-made Amtrak Midwest railcars on this route later this year."






