





Warrensburg Quick Lube and Tire opens at new location

WARRENSBURG — Warrensburg Quick Lube and Tire has moved to a new location in Warrensburg to better serve its growing number of customers and provide even quicker service than before.

On Thursday, Aug. 12, the Warrensburg Chamber of Commerce hosted a ribbon cutting ceremony to celebrate the new location.

Warrensburg Quick Lube and Tire completed its move from 611 Creach Dr., Warrensburg, to 211 E. Young Ave., Warrensburg, on Aug. 1.

The business is co-owned by Gary Hunt, who oversees the day-to-day office operations, and Aaron Crisp, who handles the backend responsibilities.

Hunt and Crisp opened Warrensburg Quick Lube and Tire about two years ago.

They said now was the right time to upgrade to a larger facility due to the success they've had over the past couple of years and the need for more space to serve the number of customers they were receiving.

"We didn't really make the decision — Warrensburg did," Crisp said. "Warrensburg was keeping us too busy."

WARRENSBURG — Central Missouri Community Credit Union celebrated the 60th anniversary of its Warrensburg branch with a Warrensburg Chamber of Commerce ribbon cutting ceremony on Wednesday, Aug. 18.

Central Missouri Community Credit Union CEO Carol White said when the business first opened in Warrensburg back in 1961, it's main purpose was to serve as a teacher's credit union to serve university faculty. White said as time went on, the membership opened up to the community at large as it is today.

White said the business had 62 members by the end of its first year of operation and today the business has more than 15,000 members.

"It's fantastic to see it continuing to grow to help those people that we try to help," White said.

White began her time with the company in 1983 and has served as the CEO since 2007. Prior to her position as CEO, she was employed as an assistant bookkeeper, part-time teller and CFO.

White said the operations of the credit union and the banking industry in general have seen major changes in the time since she entered the field.

Many people are lucky to grow up in stable homes where they are supported with everyday acts of love and caring. **Tiffany Reed**, Executive Director of **Crossroads Hospice & Palliative Care** in Lenexa, Kansas, said she wasn't one of them. She grew up in the foster care system and it was tough.

"Growing up in the foster care system, I was not shown compassion for the majority of my life," Tiffany said. That's one reason she has a drive to bring compassion and empathy to the work of Crossroads end-of-life care teams every day. A nurse by training, Tiffany said at Crossroads she's *"learned a lot about meeting people where they are."*

Compassion Drives Her Every Move

Overseeing nursing care at inpatient substance abuse and psychiatric facilities at four locations in Kansas was what Tiffany did in her last professional position before rejoining Crossroads as Executive Director in Lenexa. Tiffany had been the Crossroads Lenexa Assistant Clinical Director in 2015 and 2016.

kept an eye out for opportunities at Crossroads and maintained close friendships with the people I had worked with," Tiffany explained. "At the end of 2019, the pieces started to fall in place."

Tiffany rejoined Crossroads just months before the pandemic hit.

"I'm a huge advocate for patient care," Tiffany said. She takes Crossroads' tagline, "Expect more from us. We do." to heart every day. Doing more all the time is her ultimate goal.





How long have you owned your business?

Warrensburg Main Street became a non profit in 1994. This year we will turn 27 and our vision is the continued economic growth and betterment of our historic downtown and community.

How and why did you get started in this line of work?

Many years ago downtown business owners started

meeting to discuss ways to promote themselves and encourage visitors to downtown. They soon heard about the Main Street approach that includes design, organization, promotions and economic vitality. They understood that their goals aligned with the National Main Street approach and that is how our organization started on the process of becoming an accredited Main Street.

What is your favorite aspect of your job?

Our organization loves to be a part of the memories made by families as they grow up in our community whether that be visits to the Saturday Farmers Market, family pictures in front of public art or attending our events such as the Patriotic Bike Parade or Burg Fest.

In what ways has your business grown and developed over the years?

There have been so many changes in our downtown in the past 26 years including street scape projects that enhanced parking, sidewalks, power poles and electricity access as well as new trees and public art. Our goal is to continue to work towards a clean, vibrant, inviting downtown where residents and visitors want to come to eat, shop and live.

In what ways has your business helped the local community?

We partner with a variety of organizations each year to provide programs and activities for the community such as the Love What's Local events including Restaurant Week, Clean the Burg, Dog Days of Summer Sale and Holiday Open House. We volunteer our time to support other organizations at their activities and events as well. We know that we are stronger together working toward the goal of creating a community that everyone loves.






SITUATIONAL SUMMARY:

In recent weeks, most areas of Missouri have experienced a surge in COVID-19 cases and hospitalizations. The Delta variant is the predominant cause. Cases in Johnson (299), Lafayette (256) and Saline (165) have increased within the past 14 days. Hospitals in the region are seeing resource strain from dramatically increased numbers of COVID-19 patients and hospitalizations. As a result, several hospitals in the region are at or near capacity. Continued disease spread into Northwest Missouri is expected.*

The percentage of people fully vaccinated in Johnson (23.4.0%), Lafayette (34.5%) and Saline (35.8%) counties. Experts say at least 70% - 80% of people, depending on the type of variant virus, need immunity to provide the best chance of minimizing spread within a community.**

Delta Variant Update:

- Delta cases are on the rise and the variant appears to spread more easily and poses higher risk of hospitalization than prior strains.
- Vaccination is the best way to prevent COVID-19. Social distancing, masking, handwashing, and other precautions remain important.

Value of Vaccination for Individuals:

- All approved vaccines are very effective, even against new variants.
- There is no cost for the COVID-19 vaccine, even if you are uninsured.
- Fully vaccinated individuals are less likely to miss work, school, or social functions due to illness.
- Fully vaccinated individuals are not asked to quarantine when exposed to COVID-19 and not symptomatic.

Value of Vaccination for Workplaces/Communities:

- Helps prevent or reduce outbreaks that create high absenteeism in businesses and hamper community social events.

Do you know how to 'pre-frame' your small talk?

TIP: Do you know how to 'pre-frame' your small talk?

When was the last time you talked to a stranger? With most of us being locked down or wearing a face mask when we ventured outdoors, we likely haven't tried to strike up a conversation with someone we didn't know in quite a while. Our skills may be a bit rusty.

Journalist Joe Keohane, in *How to Become a Master at Talking to Strangers* shares advice he received from expert Georgie Nightingall. Nightingall suggests you "pre-frame" your conversation with a stranger by saying something upfront that lets them know that *you recognize* most people are uncomfortable talking to strangers. "Look I know we're not supposed to talk to people on the subway, but..."

This helps set expectations, "alleviate wariness and opens the possibility of a connection. Once that is established, Nightingall says, you follow the pre-frame with your statement — 'I really like your sunglasses,' for instance. Then you follow that with a justification: 'I just lost mine and I've been looking for a new pair.' The justification eases the person's suspicion that you have some kind of agenda and allows you to talk a little more openly."





COVID-19 EIDL

Funds Available for SBA's COVID-19 Economic Injury Disaster Loan Program

Kansas and Missouri Small Businesses Encouraged to Apply Prior to the December 31, 2021 Application Deadline

Small businesses that have been impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic still have time to apply for long term, low interest Economic Injury Disaster Loan (EIDL) from the U.S. Small Business Administration. These working capital loans provide a maximum of \$500,000 for small businesses to use to offset economic injury experienced during the pandemic. Proceeds of the loan may be used for credit card payments, increased wages, accumulated rent, increased cost of goods sold, and more.

The SBA has taken measures to improve the EIDL application and approval process. In late June, the COVID EIDL Loan Program was transitioned from the Office of Disaster Assistance to the Office of Capital Access (OCA). This transition included implementing new processes and performance management, and dedicating additional personnel to increase capacity of the review process. This transition resulted in daily processing of EIDL increases of 1,647 on June 28th to 37,027 on July 28th – a 22-fold increase in production efficiency. The SBA estimates that the current 600,000+ loan modification backlog to be cleared by mid-August, with most reviewed by early August. The SBA has also invested in an improved customer service experience for COVID EIDL applicants which includes more than doubling capacity, enhancing standards and response quality, and developing application completion support. The SBA will also be providing enhanced outreach efforts to deliver COVID EIDL program information to all communities, including socio-economically disadvantaged communities via partnerships, and webinars.

SBA Announces Opening of Paycheck Protection Program Direct Forgiveness Portal

The U.S. Small Business Administration is launching a streamlined application portal to allow borrowers with Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) loans of \$150,000 or less through participating lenders to apply for forgiveness directly through the SBA.

"In Region VII there are 867 lenders already signed up to use the new forgiveness portal and they completed 216,938 PPP loans under \$150,000, representing over \$4.6 billion dollars of PPP loans. The opening on this portal allows a simpler method for borrower and lender to meet the need of the business, lender and the agency," said Region 7 Acting Administrator Leon Milobar. This new change will help rush relief to over 6.5 million smallest of small businesses nationally, which has been the priority of SBA Administrator Isabel Guzman since day one.

The new forgiveness platform started accepting applications from borrowers on August 4th, 2021. Lenders are required to opt-in to this program through <https://directforgiveness.sba.gov>.

In addition to the technology platform, the SBA is standing up a PPP customer service team to answer questions and directly assist borrowers with their forgiveness applications. Borrowers that need assistance or have questions should call (877) 552-2692, Monday – Friday, 8 a.m.- 8 p.m. EST.

"This initiative will allow PPP borrowers to put their concerns of achieving full forgiveness behind them and focus on operating and growing their businesses again," said Patrick Kelley, Associate Administrator for SBA's Office of Capital Access. "We are pleased to be able to assist financial institutions across the U.S. in processing forgiveness applications for small business owners." 96% of loans went to businesses with fewer than 20 employees (compared to just 87% in 2020.)
