

This award is given to a native of Warrensburg who has operated it for nine years. Built from the ground up and is now a thriving mortgage company. In 2020, Mike Joyner and his staff continued to service the Warrensburg community despite challenges presented by COVID-19 and safety concerns. His online system made it possible to obtain financing almost entirely using virtual methods. In a year when many businesses were forced to cease operations, Mike worked hard to continue to help people who needed funding to purchase new homes or make necessary repairs.

Anyone who has lived in Warrensburg for very long knows every year brings a fresh wave of military families looking for homes near Knob Noster. Mike made sure those families and so many others had what they needed in a difficult time. Mike and his employees are active with the Chamber, participating in the annual golf tournament, and they are also a big supporter of Warrensburg Main Street. Fairway sponsors programming at Warrensburg Parks and Recreation. Mike, and many on his staff, are involved in our high school sports teams, supporting Warrensburg students.

Business of the Year (more than 15 employees)

This award goes to a business that in 2012 began a school, Christ Church Christian School, with only Kindergarten and 1st grade. They started as an early Childhood Opportunity Center with only 13 children serving birth through Pre K. Now known as Warrensburg Christian School, they recently opened a second building to accommodate more children in the community.

Warrensburg Christian School is a private school and educates students in Kindergarten through 8th grade. Their goal is to provide all of their students with an exceptional education based on a Christ-centered curriculum in a positive and nurturing learning environment. They utilize the A Beka curriculum and various teaching methods to ensure that they reach all types of learners on any development level. Warrensburg Christian School hosted and attended community events, opened up more space to accommodate more children throughout our community.

The organization we honor tonight is one of the oldest, if not the oldest, service organizations in Warrensburg. Through hard work, they have raised thousands of dollars to support many worthwhile causes. They have purchased hundreds of eyeglasses for those in need in Warrensburg. They contributed \$8,000 and hundreds of volunteer labor hours to make Lions Lake possible; it opened in June of 1975. The club is also a longstanding sponsor of many young men and women who have attended Boys State and Girls State. The members have contributed to the Food Pantry and the Christmas Store. Over the years, they have been able to raise funds for these causes by selling brooms, raffle tickets, apples and for many years held a Lions Radio Auction over KOKO Radio. Of all the funds raised, 100% has gone to the many charitable causes members support, and not one cent has been used for administrative expense. The members had also contributed out of their own pockets to help fund projects when funds were short. They might not be the most prominent service organization in Warrensburg, but with the community's help, they have provided a wealth of charitable giving. Warrensburg Lions Club is proud of its accomplishments and looks forward to many more years of service.

This location has been extremely nice for us as it has allowed us to continue working and to work out of the elements. When we started it was very difficult to do work when it was storming and in winter it is not fun doing details in 27 degree weather.

In what ways has your business helped the local community?

Beside that, just being able to detail vehicles at peoples homes, picking up their vehicles for them when they don't have a ride, or even transporting them back and forth from home or wherever they need to go while we work on their vehicles has been something that many customers have been appreciative of.

To maximize networking at a virtual conference participate as actively as you can in sessions (Q&A for example), breakout rooms, social walls, and discussion forums. Don't consider the social sessions optional "because those are the best ways to make new connections, hear a variety of perspectives, and gain insights on how others are dealing with industry changes."

JCCHS Issues Public Health Advisory

WARRENSBURG, Mo. (August 5, 2021) – With COVID-19 transmission rates in Johnson County maintaining a significant risk level, the Johnson County Community Health Services (JCCHS) Board of Trustees has approved a Public Health Advisory for the county.

The Public Health Advisory encourages individuals to take preventative measures on slowing the continued spread of COVID-19. The JCCHS Board recommends that individuals make the best decision for themselves and family. This could include following new guidance by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) identified in the advisory. Individuals are also encouraged to discuss safety precautions with their health care provider. This advisory, in accordance with the CDC, encourages fully vaccinated people within Johnson County to:

- Wear a face covering that covers nose and mouth in public indoor settings in an area of substantial or high transmission rates.
- Get tested if experiencing COVID-19 symptoms.
- Get tested 3-5 days following a known exposure to someone with suspected or confirmed COVID-19, and wear a mask in public indoor settings for 14 days.
- Isolate if you have tested positive for COVID-19 for 10 days or are experiencing symptoms. The CDC also recommends universal indoor masking for all teachers, staff, students and visitors to schools, regardless of vaccination status.

Additionally, this advisory recommends unvaccinated people within Johnson County to:

- Talk to your health care provider about the COVID -19 vaccine.
- Get the COVID-19 vaccine if qualify.
- Wear a face covering that covers the nose and mouth.
- Physical distance when around others who do not live in the same household.
- Avoid crowds and poorly ventilated indoor spaces.
- Wash hands often with soap and water. Use hand sanitizer when soap and water are unavailable.
- If exposed, follow the proper quarantine procedures.
- If symptomatic, seek out testing for COVID-19.
- If tested positive, isolate from others for at least 10 days, and notify anyone who would be considered a close contact.

Face coverings should not be placed on young children under age 2, anyone who has trouble breathing, or is unconscious, incapacitated or otherwise unable to remove the mask without assistance.
