
- How to get your business to show up higher in local search results

The Big Idea Business Pitch Competition is coming up on April 22nd as a virtual event (with preliminary rounds happening prior to the event). This streamlining of the process means that we have been able to reduce your time commitment to a single day. In a nutshell, here's what we are asking: Being a judge includes participating in:

- 1) Final Pitch Competition: Attend the virtual session and serve as a judge for the final rounds of the competitors on Friday, April 22nd, from 1:00-4:00 p.m., including Q&A with the competitors. Attached is the rubric we will be using to evaluate the pitches. You will complete an online survey using the same criteria to rank the competitors in real-time as they complete their pitches.
- 2) Top 3 Pitches: Based on the ratings, the top 3 competitors will deliver their pitches in front of all of the judges to determine the rank order finish. Judges will vote in real-time online (a link to the survey will be provided that day). We will need 20 judges in total.



We have been operating under a yellow flag (and sometimes a red flag) when it comes to networking face-to-face. It appears that it is now a green flag. After such a long hiatus you might be wondering...where should I go to start networking again?

# TIP: In a hybrid work world when are face-to-face meetings necessary?

Tobias Stone in an article, 4 Types of Post-Covid Meetings, makes the argument that meetings that are purely informational will probably be done virtually. But there are other meetings that will require face-to-face connecting, and those are meetings that build social capital.

"These are less about information exchange and more about connecting, bonding, building a relationship. Social capital meetings will be with new people you are getting to know or people with whom you need to maintain social capital. These will become the meetings people prioritize to do in person and may be the second or third interaction with a new contact after some initial video calls where information is exchanged."

Social capital meetings will include:

Internal team meetings where co-workers bond and share ideas with each other.

Meetings with people you like. If you enjoy that person's company you will be more likely to make the commute to meet in person.

Stone goes on to say, "These meetings will also mainly happen over food, as that's how people bond." We think that is a very good idea we can all explore as we start reconnecting face-to-face.



### JCCHS Announces COVID-19 Endemic Phase for Johnson County

WARRENSBURG, Mo. (April 8, 2022) – Recently, Governor Mike Parson announced an end to the COVID-19 crisis in Missouri and has moved into an endemic phase. Based on the county's current COVID-19 numbers, Johnson County Community Health Services (JCCHS) has also moved forward with the endemic phase of the pandemic. JCCHS will no longer provide weekly updates on COVID-19. To view the most recent numbers, individuals are encouraged to visit the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) website at https://covid.cdc.gov/covid-data-tracker/#datatracker-home.

The COVID-19 virus is expected to continue circulating in the community, making it considered endemic like many other diseases. Testing resources, vaccines, and treatments are readily available to help fight COVID-19.

JCCHS provides both Antigen and PCR testing by appointment. JCCHS also provides the COVID-19 vaccine every Wednesday, during a walk-in clinic from 1 PM to 4:30 PM and extended hours on the first Wednesday of each month from 1 PM to 6 PM. This includes first, second and booster doses for both Pfizer and Moderna vaccines.

JCCHS has discontinued contact tracing and changes from monitoring case number to monitoring disease severity and impact on the community as new waves of infection are anticipated and come and go. JCCHS will continue to provide public health surveillance, investigation, and response activities as necessary to mitigate the spread.
