Tip: If you read one article on networking, this is it.

Tip: How to make friends at the office when you work remotely.





### TIP: If you read one article on networking, this is it.

And it is not ours, it's from Herminia Ibarra. In her Harvard Business Review article Professor Ibarra has nailed the top misconceptions people have about networking. After two decades of teaching the skills of networking, we agree completely with her top five:

Misconception 1: Networking is mostly a waste of time.

Misconception 2. People are either naturally gifted at networking or they are not, and it's generally difficult to change that.

Misconception 3: Relationships should form naturally

Misconception 4. Networks are inherently self-serving or selfish.

Misconception 5: Our strong ties are the most valuable.

We think this is a valuable article for anyone who is onboarding at your firm and likely has these misconceptions about networking.

### TIP: How to make friends at the office when you work remotely.

Meena Thiruvengadam in her blog post Yes, You Can Still Make Friends at Work If You're Remote, says "Just because there's no seltzer dispenser to gossip around, no cafeteria to gather in, or no office to go to, doesn't mean you can't make friends with your colleagues".

Introducing yourself is often the hardest part--you wonder who to reach out to, and then what's your reason for reaching out. Here's some good advice from Meena.

Introduce yourself.

Start by reaching out to the people on your team. Next, reach out to your broader department and to other colleagues you find yourself collaborating with on projects.

If you're struggling to come up with the right words, ask your new colleague to tell you more about their role or their team.

Once you have reached out, perhaps having established a virtual coffee date or Slack channel, now try and make that human connection -- show your personality, share things about yourself, just like in-person friendships.

Meena's advice:

Be human.
