Tip: What's the right time to show up?





Tip: Cross-pollinate your network?

#### TIP: What's the right time to show up?

Joe Pinsker offers a tongue-in-cheek answer in "A mathematical formula for the right time to show up at a party". Since parties are coming back into fashion, you might want to know the answer (38 minutes after the start). And yes, he even offers a mathematical formula!

For **business networking events** here's our suggestion on the best time to show up.

If there is a reception before the event starts (which is common for breakfast, luncheon, dinner, or speaker events) go to the reception! Many people avoid the reception because it's **the networking part** and some people might want to avoid the networking. But go, because that's where you get to circulate and meet more people than just those sitting at your table.

If the reception starts at 6:00 pm for a 7:30 pm dinner, arrive at 6:30 or 6:45 pm. You don't want to be one of the first people--it could be a pretty empty room! But give yourself enough time to network before the event. And remember when the room isn't crammed with people, it will be easier to talk without shouting at the other person--which is definitely one of the least fun things about the whole networking scene, right?

#### TIP: Cross-pollinate your network?

We are big fans of author and Duke and Columbia business school prof Dorie Clark and love her term cross-pollinate your networks. The real bonus is you get to bring people from both of your networks together.

Obviously, cross-pollination is better if each of you have your own diverse networks. You can also improve the cross-pollination by asking the core group you've invited to bring along one or two fresh faces.

Post-pandemic why not embrace a bigger, more inclusive, more diverse, more interesting network? The formula is easy: Eat, Drink, Converse, Repeat.



### Missouri Safety Center Partners with National Program, KCPD to Offer Nocost Officer Safety Training at Regional Academy in July, August

WARRENSBURG, MO -- The Missouri Safety Center at the University of Central Missouri is pleased to announce its partnership with the National Law Enforcement Roadway Safety Program (NLERSP) and the Kansas City Police Department to provide no-cost officer safety training to law enforcement professionals at the Kansas City Police Department Regional Police Academy during the months of July and August, 2022. The NLERSP training will provide law enforcement executives, supervisors, trainers, and patrol officers with evidence-based strategies and tactics to improve officer safety during traffic stops, emergency response driving, all-weather driving, and roadway operations.

NLERSP courses are taught by current and former law enforcement officers, trainers, and executives who specialize in patrol operations, emergency vehicle operations, training development and delivery, personnel management, and policy development and implementation.

Motor vehicle collisions and struck-by incidents pose a serious risk to officer safety. According to data collected by the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial Fund, 499 law enforcement officers died from roadway-related incidents from 2012 to 2021.

The National Law Enforcement Roadway Safety Program provides training, technical assistance, and resources to local, state, and tribal law enforcement agencies with the goal of reducing the number of officers injured or killed on the nation's roadways. The NLERSP was developed, and is currently managed, by the National Policing Institute and the Institute for Intergovernmental Research, with funding provided by the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance. # Missouri Attorney General Grants Community Partnership Award to UCM Public Safety for Role in Helping with SAFE Kit Initiative

WARRENSBURG, MO – The University of Central Missouri's Department of Public Safety was recently recognized by Missouri Attorney General Eric Schmitt as the recipient of a Community Partner Award. Public Safety was one of more than 650 Missouri entities, including law enforcement and hospitals, to receive this commendation for their vital assistance in completing the Phase II inventory of sexual assault kits with the state's SAFE Kit Initiative. Certificates recognizing each of these organizations were mailed in June.

"The success of the SAFE Kit initiative depends on active participation from hospitals and law enforcement agencies willing to dedicate the time and effort to help us clear the backlog of untested sexual assault kits and achieve justice for victims," Schmitt said in a press release. "We wanted to highlight the wonderful work these departments and medical facilities have done and thank them for their continued partnership with our office on this vital initiative."

Schmitt's office appointed Judge M. Keithley Williams to lead the effort that is made possible by several federal grants from the Bureau of Justice Assistance with funding disbursed by the state legislature. The SAFE Kits initiative was actually launched in Missouri on Feb. 27, 2019.

UCM Public Safety Officer Gary Schmidt was instrumental in working with his colleagues to coordinate the campus effort to eliminate a backlog of untested kits to get them tested and entered into CODIS (Combined DNA Index System). CODIS is the FBI's national database of DNA profiles from both known and unknown offenders and arrestees. When these profiles are uploaded, they can be compared against existing records for matches, or "hits," which can help identify perpetrators who may have committed crimes locally or in other states.

#### Habitat for Humanity Partners with WILS

Marshall, MO- Habitat for Humanity partnered with their regional Missouri Center for Independent Living, WILS, to construct a ramp at a local couple's home.

Jim Brown, age 84, and Carroll Brown, age 81, have lived in Marshall since 1969 and like the town and community very much. However, in the last 5 years Carroll has had several health issues that necessitated many trips to the doctor and hospital. She is mostly bed bound which made the steps in and out of their home a serious challenge. Even the ambulance crews had trouble getting a gurney up & down the stairs. Jim says that the ramp is a "Godsend" because he can get Carroll into the car much easier. He told WILS and Habitat for Humanity how grateful he and Carroll both were for constructing the ramp.

Ronda Wickham, secretary for the Habitat for Humanity of Saline County organization, said, "It is a privilege to partner with WILS to help families when circumstances make special accommodations necessary. Our group has some very talented people who volunteer their time and expertise to help those whose disabilities make it difficult to use stairs."

WILS has a long-standing working relationship with Habitat for Humanity, having built ramps together since 2008. Working with Habitat for Humanity volunteers is amazing because it allows WILS to get projects completed quickly, while meeting the high quality standards of both organizations. Funding is made possible through grants, corporate and individual donations, and fundraising activities.

"WILS works to empower individuals with disabilities to achieve or maintain their independence and our partnership with Habitat for Humanity enhances our mission. As a onestop resource center, WILS is the place people can count on to find out what service options are available to them in their community. This knowledge allows individuals to make informed decisions about the services which best meet their needs," says WILS Senior Executive Assistant, Kathy Wyatt.

#### Cash Money SuperDirt Late Models and Weekly Racing Saturday at Central Missouri Speedway!

(Warrensburg, Missouri) After a week off for rest and relaxation for the Central Missouri Speedway (CMS) staff, the gates swing back open on Saturday evening as the final third of the 2022 season begins. The Cash Money Super Dirt Series Late Models will headline the action with a \$1,000-to-win main event. Fans will also take in a full night of action featuring B-Mods, POWRi Super Stocks and Midwest Mods, plus Pure Stocks!

The DirtTrack Bank CMSDS Late Models will compete in a full program of preliminary heat races and a main event during the race program. Through 11 events so far this season, Webb City, Missouri driver Mitch Keeter sits atop the standings with seven victories. Jace Parmley, Mike Bitner, Justin Pearish, and Shawn Duncan round out the top five. Now in its fifth year as an organization, Keeter is the all-time winningest driver with the series. A list of additional drivers who have raced with the tour this year include Dustin Mooneyham, former CMS competitor Chris Hawkins, Jim Body, and Justin Wells. Note, mention of driver name does not quarantee race appearance.

On the CMS home front, the weekly championship battles continue in the B-Mods with Terry Schultz leading the way over Stephen Clancy by 79 markers. Blaine Ewing holds a slim 14-point lead over defending POWRi National Champion Aaron Poe in Super Stock action. Spencer Reiff of Kansas City leads Warrensburg driver Jerett Evans in Pure Stock action while Shawn Burns holds a commanding lead over Dustin Dennison of Independence, Missouri, in POWRi Midwest Mods. 




