Tip: Are emojis just cute, or a real way to connect at work?



Tip: Very cool LinkedIn feature if you are taking a career break.

TIP: Are emojis just cute, or a real way to connect at work?

Remote communication makes it harder to express emotions or know how others are feeling. If you think using emojis in your office communication might be the solution, here's what Tomoko Yokoi an advisor in digital transformations at IMD Business School and Jennifer Jordan a professor of leadership and organizational behavior at IMD say about them.

"They can help clarify meaning behind digital communications, as well as the type and strength of emotions being expressed."

There researchers share how one senior leader at a global consumer products company "uses emojis and GIFs to help motivate his team members and colleagues: I use them as 'pick-me-ups' to energize and to drive positive moods and behaviors within my team."

When employees at Danske Bank log on to join a remote management meeting, they share an emoji. "Our virtual meetings start with capturing the mood of the day... Emojis allows us to reflect upon and express a broader range of feelings beyond the standard verbal response of 'I'm fine.'"

Yokoi and Jordan suggest you start with "simple emojis (e.g., thumbs up) rather than emojis that represent complex emotions (e.g. laughing emojis with tears) in order to decrease the likelihood that an emoji will offend." TIP: Very cool LinkedIn feature if you are taking a career

There are lots of reasons why people take a pause in their career and what LinkedIn has found is "even with career breaks becoming more popular, some hiring managers are still hesitant to pursue those who have taken a break — indeed, one in five hiring managers say they outright reject such candidates."

Now people can add a Career Break to their LinkedIn Profile and talent professionals or recruiters will see this "highlighted pause" explained (and in a way legitimized), rather than just seeing a time gap in a person's career.

While you may not be planning a career break, you can share this cool new feature with friends and colleagues who are planning a break, or are currently on one. Sharing something helpful is a great way to reconnect with people in your network.
