WARRENSBURG, MO (August 11, 2022) – The Warrensburg Community Center (WCC) building and grounds are controlled-access facilities under the direction of Warrensburg Parks & Recreation (WPR). The building and Code of Conduct Rules are posted around the building as well as on the website. WPR has recently made some changes to the age restrictions, which include the following:

- Youth ages 10 and under must be accompanied by a parent or guardian (age 18+) within the WCC at all times unless participating in a WPR program/activity (effective immediately)
- Youth 11-17 years old entering the facility unaccompanied by an adult (age 18+), unless participating in a WPR program/activity, MUST have a WPR Account with photo, current address, phone number and a WCC Youth Account Contract signed by youth and guardian and on file (effective October 1) before using the facility
- Youth ages 15 & under must be accompanied by an adult to use the Track. They will not be allowed in the Fitness & Equipment Area (effective immediately)




