Tip: Be open to anyone. Here's why...

#### TIP: When to 'stop with the small talk."

When you first meet someone, or reconnect with an acquaintance at a business networking event, do you find yourself stuck in 'small talk' mode? It seems weird to suddenly change gears from talking about the weather, sports, or summer vacation plans to business talk, but that is most likely WHY you are both at the networking event.

As a solution try slowly shifting the conversation in the direction of work and business. Perhaps ask "How many people at your office are still working remotely this summer?" Then follow up by asking about their business and if working from home is working for them.

Perhaps you do have to make a pivot from 'small talk' by directly asking about their work. If you know what they do, then make your question relevant to their work life. It could be supply chain issues people are facing. Or inflation or any number of more business-related topics. Devin Cleary Gooden in Networking Works: Here's How One
Connection Changed My Entire Career tells the story of building a
friendship with a work colleague who she otherwise wouldn't have
"gravitated toward" and how later that person leveraged her
connections when Devin was looking to changes jobs. Gooden was
new to work and "met this individual in the office one day when our
desks were rearranged, and we found ourselves sitting close
together. She was on a different team and from what I could tell, we
didn't have much in common...she was older than me... and she
already had a strong network of connections in the office with whom
she regularly hung out with. I figured we'd be friendly to each other
and go about our business-like regular coworkers, but we ended up
connecting way beyond that.

When I ended up leaving the company...she leveraged her connections to get me a meeting with the hiring director, and a few years later, she randomly invited me into a top-secret Slack group for marketers in our city (who even knew those existed?!) which is where I found my current role that I love. That, and I ended up tripling my salary over the course of four years as I changed jobs which is something I can tie directly back to my colleague."










### Chamber of Commerce


