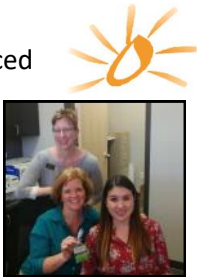

The hand stamp is used in place of a postage stamp, or the permit indicia is available in electronic format to make printing and mailing easier. Chamber Benefit Plan

This self-funded medical offering called the Chamber Benefit Plan is a multiple employer welfare arrangement (MEWA). The Chamber Benefit Plan enables smaller employers (50 or fewer eligible employees) to join together to share in the overall claims risk.

Located in the depot behind the Chamber office, the JMCR is available to rent for meetings, seminars, or other events any day or night of the week. Chamber members receive a significantly reduced rental rate. The room includes a kitchenette with a sink and refrigerator, is wheelchair accessible, and bathroom facilities are available in the depot. There is ample parking and the room has its own entrance.
