THE PROBLEM

According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 42,915 people were killed in traffic crashes in 2021.

Distracted driving claimed at least 3,142 lives nationwide in 2020 alone. And thousands of additional lives could have been saved with the use of seat belts.

With no primary seat belt law nor all-driver texting ban, Missouri looked for a new approach to reversing these dangerous trends.

THE MOVEMENT

On October 12, 2022, the USCIS announced that employers should continue to use the current Form I-9 after its expiration date of October 31, 2022, until further notice. It is anticipated that the Department of Homeland Security will publish a new one-page Form I-9 in the coming months. Thus, until the new version of the Form I-9 is published and effective, employers should continue to use the current version of the I-9 form.

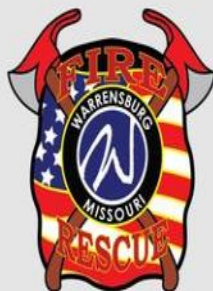

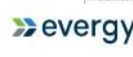

According to McKinsey, professionals spend 28 percent of the workday reading and answering email. Time management company Zarvana says people check their email an average of 15 times a day. That's a lot of time.

Wharton psychologist and best-selling author, [Adam Grant](#), believes we can reduce our email time by simply telling the recipient **when** we need a response and **why**. As explained in an [Inc. article by Minda Zetlin](#), Professor Grant suggests adding a sentence like this to the end of every email:

"If you can, I would appreciate a response by _____ so that _____." For example: If you can, I would appreciate a response by Thursday morning so that we can make our final decision on how many tickets to purchase for the event.

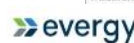


CIS Celebrates Ribbon Cutting for New UCM-Aureus AI and Analytics Lab at Missouri Innovation campus

The enthusiastic response to the first shipment of 400 pianos resulted in more orders for O.D.G.I. (Olive Drab Government Issue) "field" pianos.
