





#### TIP: Try adding this one sentence to your emails.

According to McKinsey, professionals spend 28 percent of the workday reading and answering email. Time management company Zarvana says people check their email an average of 15 times a day. That's a lot of time.

Wharton psychologist and best-selling author, <u>Adam</u> <u>Grant</u>, believes we can reduce our email time by simply telling the recipient **when** we need a response and **why**. As explained in an <u>Inc. article by</u> <u>Minda Zetlin</u>, Professor Grant suggests adding a sentence like this to the end of every email:

"If you can, I would appreciate a response by\_\_\_\_\_\_so that \_\_\_\_\_\_." For example: If you can, I would appreciate a response by Thursday morning so that we can make our final decision on how many tickets to purchase for the event. TIP: Take the bull by the horns.

The title of Jessica Stillman's article in Inc. says it all, <u>Yet Another Study Confirms You're Wildly</u> <u>Underestimating How Much People Want to Help</u> <u>You.</u>

She says a "treasure trove of studies show we are terrible at judging how others will react to us, and not just when it comes to asking for favors. Research shows we overestimate the awkwardness of saying thank you, worry excessively about looking dumb when asking for advice, and underestimate how much people appreciate feedback." Of course, the obvious tip is this: Don't worry about asking for advice, and perhaps ask for advice more often.








#### Whiteman Area Leadership Council Awarded Missouri Military communities Grant

(Whiteman AFB, MO) The Whiteman Area Leadership Council (WALC) was awarded \$33,500 through the Military Community Reinvestment Grant Program (MCRG). WALC is a 501c3 non-profit organization which was formed to bring regional communities, citizens, governments, organizations, state and federal offices and agencies together with Whiteman Air Force Base (WAFB) as strategic partners to make the region an even better place to live, work, learn and play, while enhancing the quality of life for airmen and their families at WAFB.

Five needs have registered as key considerations for Air Force personnel and their families across the U.S. These are: Housing, childcare, license portability, health care and education. This grant award will be focused on a Child Care Assessment and Action Plan for a 30-mile radius of WAFB, to include but not limited to the communities of Knob Noster, Sedalia and Warrensburg. With this information, WALC, stakeholders and communities will have a better of understanding of the regional child care landscape and ways in which to enhance it.

With this grant, we can be proactive in identifying childcare needs and confirming areas to be strengthened. #### New Mule Grant Fills Financial gap Not **Covered by Other Grants and** Scholarships to Make UCM Degree More Accessible and Affordable

WARRENSBURG, MO (Oct. 19, 2022) - In an effort to ensure cost does not dampen a student's ability to pursue their higher education goals, the University of Central Missouri announces the new Mule Grant program. An initiative just in time for students who are residents of the state of Missouri and plan to begin their undergraduate education in fall 2023, this program is designed to fund the gap between the total cost of tuition and general fees and those expenses covered by federal, state and institutional grants and scholarships. "We are excited to expand on our scholarship offerings again with this new need-based grant for students who are trying to decide if they are able to afford to go to college or not," said Chris Lang, assistant vice provost for Admissions and Analytics at UCM. "Keeping with UCM's mission to increase access and affordability, this grant will allow more students to realize their dreams and further their education without taking on overly burdensome debt to achieve it. "Victory Vertical Pianos" were manufactured during WW II by the Steinway Piano company with the specific mission of enhancing the "morale and resolve" of soldiers in the field. The pianos were small, boxlike instruments that were packed in a crate; they came with sheet music, instructions, tools for tuning and repair, and had handles for easy transport. The enthusiastic response to the first shipment of 400 pianos resulted in more orders for O.D.G.I. (Olive Drab Government Issue) "field" pianos.







