



We've been talking with colleagues about the challenges of creating bonds between co-workers or customers when those interactions are virtual. We came across an article written specifically about email messages, 6 *Creative Intros Beyond "I Hope This Email Finds You Well"*, but these ideas apply to virtual connecting as well.

These suggestions by author Regina Borsellino might be worth trying as a way to jumpstart an online conversation before getting down to business.

-- I hope your pitch to the new client is coming together nicely!

TIP: Another idea on how to remember names.

We admit we still have a challenge remembering names. A person says their name and somehow that name just evaporates. Is it because experience tells us we will forget it, and so that's where our brain goes? Or is it because we're so busy focusing on the next step... engaging the other person in conversation?

Malia Wollan in the <u>article in *The New York*</u> <u>*Times* Magazine</u> offered this advice from a person who has to remember names for a living! Indira Pun, chief concierge at Mandarin Oriental Hong Kong says "your brain needs to be like a camera...take a picture in your mind of a unique thing about that person and register that uniqueness with their name." It's that "mental shot", like a photo, that seems like a good idea to us.

Care Connection Launches Kinship Connection Program

(Sept. 20, 2022) If you are one of the estimated 3 million older adults raising their grandchildren in the United States, Care Connection can provide support for your family.

Care Connection has partnered with ParentLink of University of Missouri and Trails Regional Library Warrensburg branch to present a regular support group for grandparents and other relatives raising children in Johnson County. The new group is part of the Kinship Connection program to serve relatives raising children.

The first meeting will be from 9 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. Oct. 18 and continue the third Tuesday of every month at the library, 432 N. Holden St.

All participants will receive a free gift pack at each meeting, and the program will offer kinship caregiver credit for licensure through the state of Missouri.

Each session will provide practical information that adults 55 and older can use in their daily role as a grandparent or relative raising a child. Topics include challenges and stressors, wellbeing of children, and ways to help oneself and family.

ParentLink has curriculum that covers parenting subjects such as grief, valuing cultural differences, trauma, the impact of substance abuse, providing stability, and self-esteem.

Participation in the group is free, but registration is preferred. To register, call Tammy Wilkey at 660-438-3300, ext. 3, or Lisa Lewis at 800-748-7826.

Kinship Connection will be more than just a job assignment for Wilkey, a single grandmother raising three young grandchildren - a girl and two boys.

WARRENSBURG, MO (Oct. 5, 2022) - University of Central Missouri (UCM) Theatre and Dance presents the play "Stop Kiss" by Diana Son in the Nickerson Black Box Theatre Oct. 6-9. "Stop Kiss" is the opening play of UCM Theatre and Dance's 2022-2023 Mainstage Season, which is themed "HERstory," providing presentations dedicated to women and their stories.

This moving play tells the story of Callie and Sara, their budding relationship and a horrific crime that occurs. The play will be performed at 7:30 p.m. Thursday, Friday and Saturday, Oct. 6-8 with the play on

Oct. 7 including an ASL interpreter. In addition to these evening performances, there are matinees at 2 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday, Oct. 8-9. This play is for mature audiences only and contains strong language and the description and resulting effects of a hate crime.

While sharing their first kiss a violent attack takes place, transforming their lives in a way they could never anticipate. The play journeys through the aftermath of the attack and relationship between Callie and Sara.

Governor Announces UCM as Recipient of \$300,000 Grant to Support Nursing **Education Programs, Reduce Staffing** Shortages in Field

WARRENSBURG, MO (Sept. 22, 2022) - The University of Central Missouri is one of 11 Missouri public and private colleges and universities that will benefit from nearly \$3 million in grant funding from Governor Mike Parson to support nursing education programs and the development of solutions to alleviate staffing shortages area nationwide. Missouri Governor Mike Parson announced this initiative this week. UCM will receive \$300,000, according to the governor's office. The competitive grants were part of a special appropriation to the Missouri State Board of Nursing that was recommended by the governor. "My administration has prioritized workforce

development, especially for our high demand fields such as nursing," Governor Parson said. "It is vitally important that we continue to invest in Missouri's health care workforce. These grant funds will assist in expanding clinical partnerships and nursing resources to better provide students with a valuable education as well as increase enrollment capacity in the future." Funds were awarded to nursing programs that have proposed innovative solutions to assist in alleviating the nursing shortage, the governor's office stated. Read More


