## **Carson First at UCM to Receive NIJ Grant: Will Pursue Study Contributing to Better Understanding of Left-Wing and Environmental Terrorism in U.S.**

WARRENSBURG, MO (Nov. 8, 2022) – The principal investigator of a research project designed to develop data sources that could potentially inform law enforcement policy and counterterrorism efforts, Jennifer Carson, Ph.D., professor of criminology and criminal justice at the University of Central Missouri, has been awarded a \$506,497 grant from the National Institute of Justice (NIJ). This three-year financial award includes collaboration with faculty members at three other institutions in the United States and abroad.

Carson, who also serves as director of UCM's Honors College, learned in September that the grant proposal submitted to the NIJ, with assistance from Sarah Craig, director of Sponsored Programs and Research Integrity at UCM, has been funded through the NIJ Fiscal Year 2022 Research and Evaluation on Domestic Radicalization and Violent Extremism program. The grant to UCM was one of only two awards nationally that received funding under this initiative, and it is the first grant the NIJ has ever awarded to UCM.

## **UCM Announces In-State Tuition Rate for Military and Veteran Dependents**

WARRENSBURG, MO (Nov. 11, 2022) – While the University of Central Missouri has a longstanding commitment to making higher education more affordable for individuals who currently serve in the military as well as veterans, UCM is not forgetting the families of those who dedicate their lives to this country. When it met on campus recently, UCM's Board of Governors approved a recommendation to expand the university's in-state tuition rates to dependents of service members and veterans.

Bill Hawley, vice president for finance and operations at the university, presented the dependent tuition proposal to the board, noting that it aligns with best practices and also is in compliance with Veterans Affairs (VA) requirements related to students who are using transfer of entitlement under Post-9/11 GI Bill® and the Survivors and Dependents Educational Assistance Program. Following board approval, it is now effective for fall 2023.

This measure benefits dependents of active duty, guard, and reserve members of the military regardless of the state where the military member is serving. It also applies to dependents of veterans who do not have VA educational entitlement, and to dependents who have exhausted their VA educational entitlement, according to Hawley.

## Generous \$5M Gift Supports Global Vision Endowment Exemplifying UCM's Role in Providing 'Education for Service'

WARRENSBURG, MO (Nov. 10, 2022) – The Global Vision Endowment, a program that has helped engage more than 100 University of Central Missouri students in service to individuals living in impoverished areas around the globe, is receiving a significant financial uplift thanks to a generous \$5 million estate gift from an anonymous donor. The gift to support UCM students was recently announced by Michael Sawyer, dean of the university's College of Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences (CAHSS), in cooperation with the institution's Alumni Foundation. 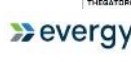
