It is the time of year when the Optimist Club of Warrensburg beings planning for their annual essay and oratorical contests. Last year --- The Optimist Club of Warrensburgs oratorical contestant Abigail Richner, who won the clubs local oratorical contest, won the Middle America Regional at the Optimist International Oratorical World Championships. The Seventh Annual Optimist International Oratorical World Championships took place at Saint Louis University on July 21-22, 2022. As the Mid America Regional Winner, Richner won a \$5.000 college scholarship. She went on to compete in the world finals with her amazing take on this years' topic 'Staying Optimistic in Challenging Times," Richner won a total of \$7,500 in scholarships through the oratorical contest

Since its start in 1928, the Optimist Oratorical Contest has become the longest-running program sponsored by Optimist International. This year's oratorical topic, "Discovering the Optimism Within Me" is a challenge everyone has experienced during these trying times. The contest is designed for youth to gain experience in public speaking and provide them with the opportunity to compete for a college scholarship. Interested students should prepare a 4- to 5minute speech on the assigned topic.

The theme of this year's Essay Contest is "Who is an Everyday Hero that Brings Out the Optimism in You?" Essays must contain at least 700 words but no more than 800 words. Our Club winner will be sent directly to the District competition

Please note that students can compete in both the essay and oratorical contests. They are not restricted to just one. Youth of all ages are encouraged to compete and gain experience and give their view on the topics. The contests are open to youth under the age of 19 as of October 1st of the current Optimist International contest year (October 1 - September 30) and not enrolled as a degree-seeking student of a post-secondary institution. There is no minimum age.

Freshman Legislators Learn More About **UCM During Bus Tour**

WARRENSBURG, MO – Faculty, staff and students at the University of Central Missouri shared insights into the institution where they live, work and learn when they welcomed to campus on Dec. 6 participants in the Legislative Freshman Tour.

Approximately 50 recently elected officials participated in the event. Their campus visit began with a stop at Max B. Swisher Skyhaven Airport, where they were welcomed by UCM President Roger Best, and heard remarks about airport programs and development by Matthew Furedy, chair of the Department of Aviation, and Dan Dietz, airport manager. They also heard from three aviation students who are participating in the professional pilot program.

From the airport, the group traveled to the main campus in Warrensburg. When the buses arrived on Union Street to visit the Military and Veterans Success Center, they were greeted by a brief performance by several students from the university's marching band. Inside the Elliott Student Union, Courtney Swoboda, director of Military and Veterans Services, shared information about different ways UCM assists active duty military personnel, veterans and dependents. of the Collegiate Farm Bureau were also there to greet legislators.

ARPA Grant Creates Opportunity for UCM to Establish Five Certificate Programs That will Prepare More Individuals for Missouri's Ag Workforce

WARRENSBURG, MO – Today, Governor Mike Parson announced a \$2 million grant award for the University of Central Missouri from the Missouri Department of Higher Education and Workforce Development (MDHEWD) as part of a larger \$20 million funding effort. Nearly two dozen postsecondary institutions were selected to provide highdemand career training for new and underrepresented populations and to address the economic impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on agriculture and supply chains.

With the state of Missouri facing critical training needs in its agriculture workforce, the University of Central Missouri is uniquely positioned to address workforce shortfalls within the state's agriculture segment. Today's announced \$2 million grant award, approved by the Missouri Coordinating Board for Higher Education (CBHE), requires dollar-for-dollar matching funds from UCM which can be generated through donor support. The grant complements the university's longstanding commitment to agriculture through its academic programs and embedded experiential learning components, and enables the establishment of five newly developed stackable or standalone agriculture workforce certificates in Greenhouse Management, Agritourism, Precision Agriculture, Agricultural Safety, and Agricultural Lab Research Technician areas. This will address specific challenges and labor issues faced in the field. Read More

UCM's New 737 MAX Flight Training Device a Boost to Jet Pilot Training

WARRENSBURG, MO – University of Central Missouri students who are preparing to become professional pilots have a new opportunity to get training in the cockpit of a jet aircraft long before they ever leave the ground. This opportunity is made possible through the Department of Aviation's recent acquisition of a new Boeing 737 MAX Flight Training Device (FTD), installed this fall at the Raleigh T. Gaines Technology Building.

An informal ribbon-cutting ceremony to commemorate the arrival of the new equipment was conducted in November by representatives of the aviation program and the Office of the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs. The FTD is already being put to use for advanced procedural, flight and systems training.

Action taken by the university's Board of Governors in April 2022 made possible the purchase of the FTD from Canadian company Flightdeck Solutions. This high-tech trainer was purchased at a cost of approximately \$355,000 to be paid over the next five years, plus \$29,980 for software/hardware maintenance.

Thanking Provost Phil Bridgmon for supporting the purchase, Matthew Furedy, chair of the Department of Aviation, said the new FTD was a welcome addition to the professional pilot training program. It replaces a Boeing 737 trainer that was obtained in 2008 but was no longer in use due to hardware and software issues. While the Department of Aviation expected to retire the older FTD, a technician with Flightdeck Solutions performed adjustments that are enabling UCM to continue using the older flight simulator to accommodate additional training needs in the busy department.
