What is optic fiber? A strand of optic fiber is a long, cylindrical, glass tube thinner than human hair.

## How does it work?

1010 Beams of light reflect off the glass from one end to the other, transmitting binary code.

## How fast is it?

0 Data transmission occurs nearly as fast as the speed of light. Due to a high data-carrying capacity and low transmission loss, fiber-based internet is 10-20 times faster than cable service.
