

This 16-week course will provide students education on the role of the community health worker. Students will leave the course with a better understanding of certain medical conditions and become more aware of environmental situations that are barriers to clients' health. A CHW conducts outreach services for healthcare organizations to implement programs within the community that promotes individual and encourage health.





What is optic fiber?

A strand of optic fiber is a long, cylindrical, glass tube thinner than human hair.

How does it work?

Beams of light reflect off the glass from one end to the other, transmitting binary code.



How fast is it?

Data transmission occurs nearly as fast as the speed of light. Due to a high data-carrying capacity and low transmission loss, fiber-based internet is 10-20 times faster than cable service.
