

## Community Health Worker (CHW) Online Course

This 16-week course will provide students education on the role of the community health worker. Students will leave the course with a better understanding of certain medical conditions and become more aware of environmental situations that are barriers to clients' health. A CHW conducts outreach services for healthcare organizations to implement programs within the community that promotes individual and community health.

#### Learn How To:

- Provide ongoing follow-up, basic motivational and goal setting with patients/families.
- Assist patients with completing applications and registration forms.
- Conduct eligibility determination, enrollment and follow-up with uninsured patients.
- Help patients connect with transportation resources.
- Be knowledgeable about community resources appropriate to needs of patients/families.
- Work closely with medical providers to help ensure that patients have comprehensive and coordinated care.
