Sidewalk Improvement Program!

The City Council approved an Ordinance that amended the existing Curb and Sidewalk Program and replaced it with the Sidewalk Improvement Program. The changes to the program are:

- ADA ramps and curb and gutter will be handled with the street maintenance program.
- The city will split into separate and unique 'zones'.
- Each zone will be inspected annually by the city for hazards or defects that may be affecting traffic.
- A tabulation will be put together and publicly bid for repair.
- In-zone repairs will be covered completely by the City.

Exceptions for adjoining property owners consist of:

- Out-of-zone repairs, or, out-of-program timeframe repairs (May-September) will carry a 50/50 cost share.
- Brick or stone sidewalks (if not listed on the National Register of Historic Places) will carry a 50/50 cost share; assuming the City's portion does not exceed the original cost to install concrete.

Get Legal!

What's the name of your business? Things to consider:

- Check to see if your business name is available on the Missouri Secretary of State portal at www.bsd.sos.mo.gov
- Search to ensure that there is an available website and e-mail extension to go with your business name.

What is the structure of your business?

- It is important to consult an expert before this critical decision, but a good place to start your search is at sba.gov/business-guide/launch-your-business/choose-business-structure
- Form your entity. Create an account with the State of Missouri (local legal advice is recommended) at bsd.sos.mo.gov
- Obtain a Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN) at irs.gov
- View sales tax and other tax registrations at dor.mo.gov/register-business/

Planning and Zoning!

Planning & Zoning is a division of Community Development which provides day-to-day support for the development and building community, as well as citizens of Warrensburg.

- Planning and Zoning staff administer the zoning regulations within the city limits.
- Warrensburg has 11 separate zoning districts, each with minimum lot size, building height, setback, landscaping, and other requirements.
- The official zoning map can be viewed or purchased at City Hall during business hours.

Get Licensed!

Once you have the location, you can apply for a City of Warrensburg business license. Every business is a little different so individual processes may vary.

- Visit the City Hall at 102 S. Holden Street, Warrensburg, Missouri 64093 or online at warrensburg-mo.com/35/Business
- Building Permits: Contact the Building Official if you or your landlord make any changes to the building you own or lease, or if new construction is proposed. A building permit must be obtained before construction can begin. Building permit application are submitted electronically through the City's online permit portal.
- Business License: Any business operating within the city limits of Warrensburg, including home occupations, is required to obtain a city business license. Those business pay a fee based on its gross volume of business. Certain occupations are listed specifically in the City's Code of Ordinance and are required to pay a flat fee.
- Food Related Business: Food related businesses are required to pass inspections from the Health Department before opening for business. For more information regarding food permits, contact Johnson County Community Health Services at 660-747-6121, stop by in person, or their website at johnsoncountyhealth.org/
- Retail Business: Retail locations require an approved city inspection before being open to the public. You can setup an inspection by calling the permit clerk at 660-747-9135 Business licenses may be obtained from the City Collector at City Hall.
